MOST OF US CRY. WHY DO WE CRY?

- Loss of a loved one.
- Physical in severe pain, sickness
- Emotional sadness, joy, rage
- Chopping onions, watching sad movies
- Feeling of helplessness, hopelessness and lost/loss



HEBREW WORDS FOR CRY (O.T.)

- •מְעַקּ tsa'aq cry aloud for help in distress, grief
- אַעְלָ Za'aq call for help, in need & deep distress, shriek (from anguish or danger)
- •אֹרַן qara call, cry, utter a loud sound
- •שׁוְעָה shav'ah cry for help, shout to attract attention

Crying out to God

- Helplessness, hopelessness, weaknesses, shortcoming, frailties. Its an act of humility.
- An act of desperation, plea for mercy, for God's favor
- Inabilities to overcome our mounting problems, total and unconditional surrender to God
- Utter dependence on Him who is able to do much more.
- Act of faith is in His power and resources....

More than 700 verses in Old Testament

- The righteous *cry out*, and the LORD hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles. Ps 34:17
- To the LORD I *cry aloud*, and He answers me from His holy hills. Ps3:4
- O LORD, the God who saves me, day and night I <u>cry</u> out before You. May my prayers come before You; turn Your ear to my <u>cry</u>. Ps 881-2
- Out of the depths I *cry* to You, O LORD; Ps 130:1
- Then they <u>cried</u> to the LORD in their trouble and He delivered them from their distress. Ps 107:6,13, 19, 28.....

- Hear my prayer, LORD; let my <u>cry</u> for help come to You. Ps 102:1
- He fulfills the desires of those who fear Him; He hears their <u>cry</u> and saves them Ps 145:19
- The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, and His ears are attentive to their <u>cry</u> Ps 34:15
- In my distress I *called* to the LORD; I *cried* to my God for help. From His temple He heard my voice; my *cry* came before Him, into His ears. Ps 18:6.....

- In my distress I <u>called</u> to the LORD; I <u>cried</u> to my God for help. From His temple He heard my voice; my <u>cry</u> came before Him into His ears. Ps 18:6
- Then my enemies will turn back when I <u>call</u> for help. By this I will know that God is for me. Ps 56:9
- Moses and Aaron were among his priests, Samuel was among those who <u>called</u> on His name; they <u>called</u> on the LORD and He answered them. Ps 99:6
- And <u>call</u> upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor Me. Ps 50:15
- <u>Call</u> to Me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know Jer 33:3...

- IN NEED OF DIRECTION
- They cried to the LORD in their trouble and He delivered them from their distress.
- He <u>led</u> them by a straight way, <u>satisfies</u> their thirst and hunger with good things.....

- Rebelled and despised counsel of the Most High. In bondage, blinded and surrounded by dark circumstances, feeling of failure and all alone with none to help, unfruitful labor, always striving but not achieving, addicted, trapped with no escape. Ps 107:10-12
- IN NEED OF DELIVERANCE
- They cried to the LORD in their trouble and He saved them from their distress.
- He brought them out of darkness and deepest gloom and <u>set them</u>
 <u>free</u>.....

- Infirmed, sick, walking through the valley of the shadow of death, feeling of death inside, no desire to live because of intense pain. (Afflictions caused by iniquities and rebellious ways). Ps 107:17-19
- IN NEED OF HEALING
- They cried to the LORD in their trouble and He saved them from their distress.
- He sent send forth His word and <u>healed</u> them...


