


Romans 5:12-21 The Basis of Salvation

How could one man's sacrifice have brought so much benefits to so many?

Adam and Christ introduced, contrasted, and compared ('just as')

- What one man did at one time cause all to sin
- What one man did at one time rescue all from sin




V12-14 Adam and Christ Introduced

¹² Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned— (continue onto V18b)

Sin and death came into the world through one man


Death came to all men


because all sinned



How does all men sinned through the one-man Adam?

- Augustine The original sin
 All sinned in and with Adam
 We are all born in sin
- Pelagius All sinned like Adam
 Copying and repeating Adam's sin





All sinned and died in and through Adam

¹³ To be sure, sin was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not charged against anyone's account where there is no law. 14 Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who is a pattern of the one to come.

Sin and death were already in the world before the law was given




Adam a 'prefigure' A foreshadow Christ

Adam, who is a pattern of the one to come.

Death Through Adam Life Through Christ

Adam is the head of the fallen people.

Christ is the head of the redeemed people.



In Adam - Death In Christ - Life

- All men sinned came through the one-man Adam who was there in the beginning.
- All men can be saved through the one-man Jesus who is the one to come.



V15 -17 Adam and Christ Contrasted

15 But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the one man, how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many!

Two Actions:

Trespasses vs. Gift of Grace



Two Results:

¹⁶ Nor can the gift of God be compared with the result of one man's sin: The judgment followed one sin and brought condemnation, but the gift followed many trespasses and brought justification.



Two Effects: Two Reigns

¹⁷ For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.


Death Reigned

V18-19 Adam and Christ Compared

¹⁸ Consequently, just as one trespass resulted in condemnation for all people, so also one righteous act resulted in justification and life for all people. 19 For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.

Righteousness Reigns



Adam's trespasses brought condemnation and sin.

Christ's obedience brought justification and righteousness.

The Role of the Law


²⁰ The law was brought in so that the trespass might increase.

But where sin increased, grace increased all the more,

Grace Reigns

²¹ so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Grace is more powerful than sin

Grace reigns supreme over sin and death
