GENESIS 4

- 1 Adam lay with his wife Eve, and she became pregnant and gave birth to Cain. She said, "With the help of the Lord I have brought forth a man."
- 2 Later she gave birth to his brother Abel. Now Abel kept flocks, and Cain worked the soil.
- 3 In the course of time Cain brought some of the fruits of the soil as an offering to the Lord.
- 4 And Abel also brought an offering—fat portions from some of the firstborn of his flock. The Lord looked with favor on Abel and his offering,
- 5 but on Cain and his offering he did not look with favor. So Cain was very angry, and his face was downcast.

- 6 Then the Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast?
- If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it (master it)."
- 8 Now Cain said to his brother Abel, "Let's go out to the field." While they were in the field, Cain attacked his brother Abel and killed him.
- 9 Then the Lord said to Cain, "Where is your brother Abel?" "I don't know," he replied. "Am I my brother's keeper?"
- 10 The Lord said, "What have you done? Listen! Your brother's blood cries out to me from the ground.
- 11 Now you are under a curse and driven from the ground, which opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand.


- 12 When you work the ground, it will no longer yield its crops for you. You will be a restless wanderer on the earth."
- 13 Cain said to the Lord, "My punishment is more than I can bear.
- 14 Today you are <u>driving me from the land</u>, and <u>I will be hidden from your</u> <u>presence</u>; <u>I will be a restless wanderer</u> on the earth, and <u>whoever finds me will kill me.</u>"
- 15 But the Lord said to him, "Not so; anyone who kills Cain will suffer vengeance seven times over." Then the Lord put a mark on Cain so that no one who found him would kill him.
- 16 So Cain went out from the Lord's presence and lived in the <u>land of Nod</u>, east of Eden.





4: 25 Adam lay with his wife again, and she gave birth to a son and named him Seth.

^{5:3} When Adam had lived 130 years, he had a son in his own likeness, in his own image; and he named him Seth.
