

# SERMON NOTE: Becoming A Contagious Church-The Disciples' Kingdom Prayer

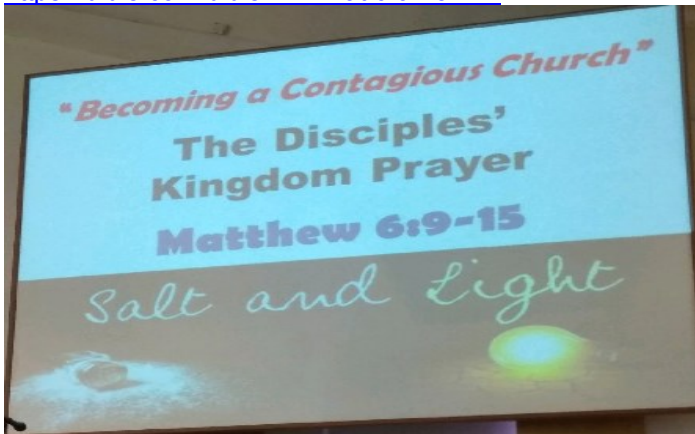

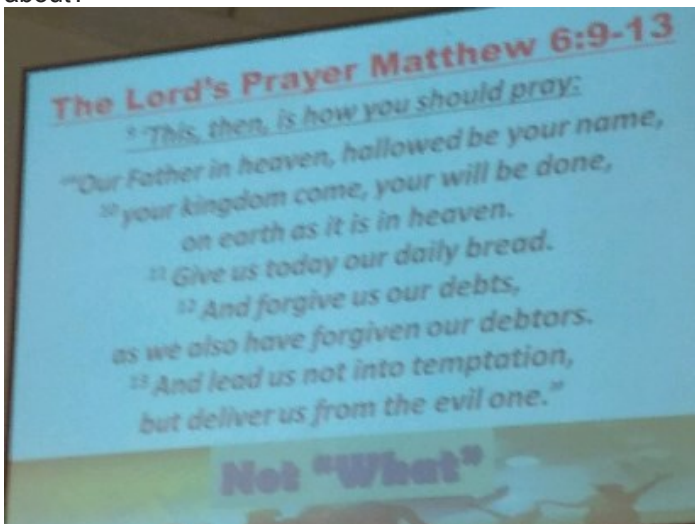
Bible Ref: Matthew 6:9-15 NIV

1. OUR FATHER in Heaven- "Our"- Communal Love for one another.

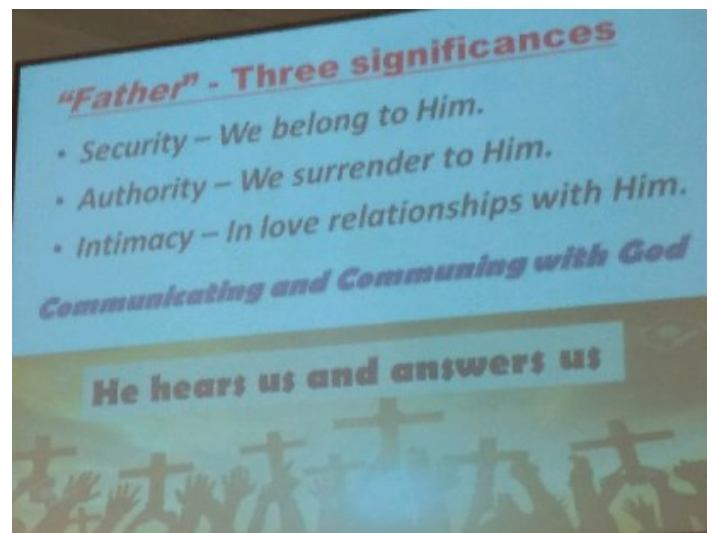
We are not alone, in our prayer and our struggles.

2. FATHER - A new way to address GOD, we are children of GOD.

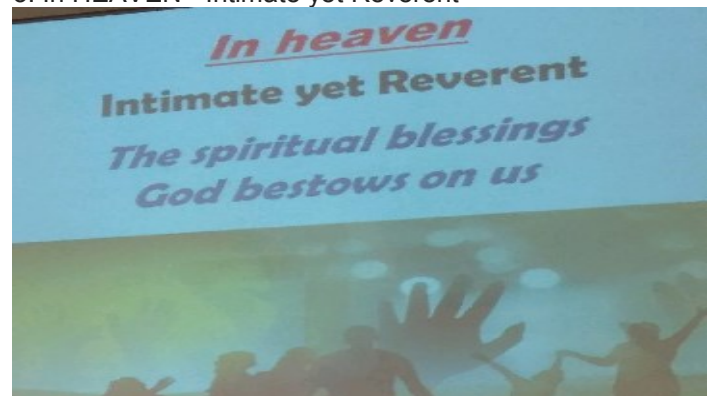
Not Just GOD of power, but GOD of Love.

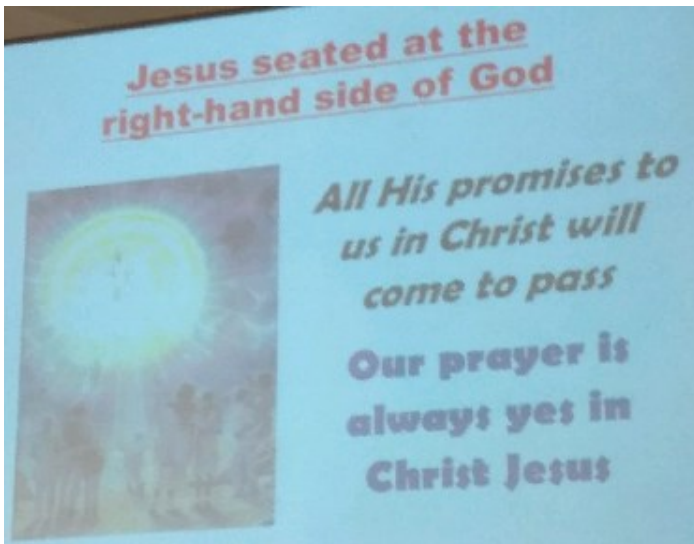


Prayer is about building relationships with GOD.

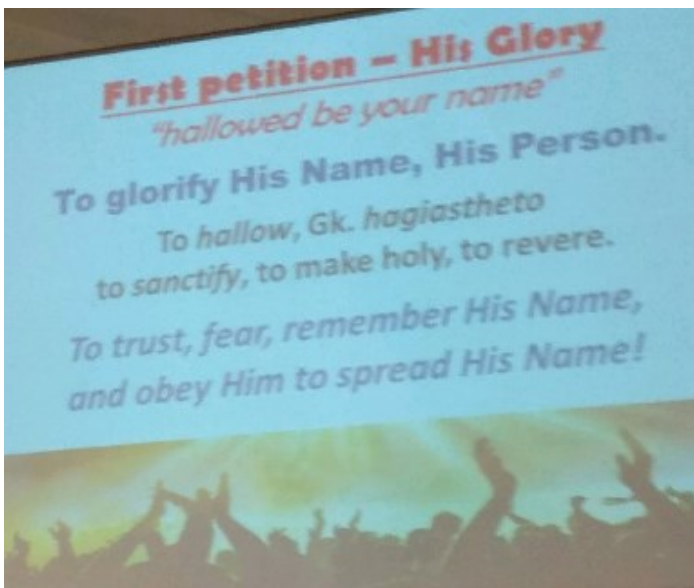


3. In HEAVEN - Intimate yet Reverent





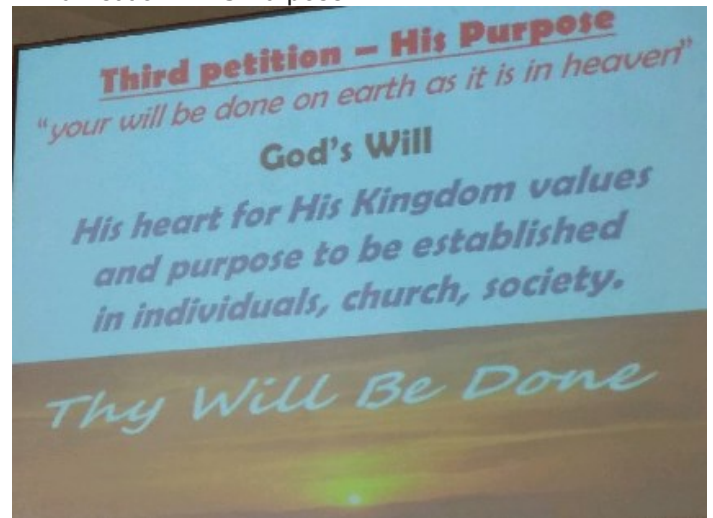
4. The Petitions - The First Three Petitions



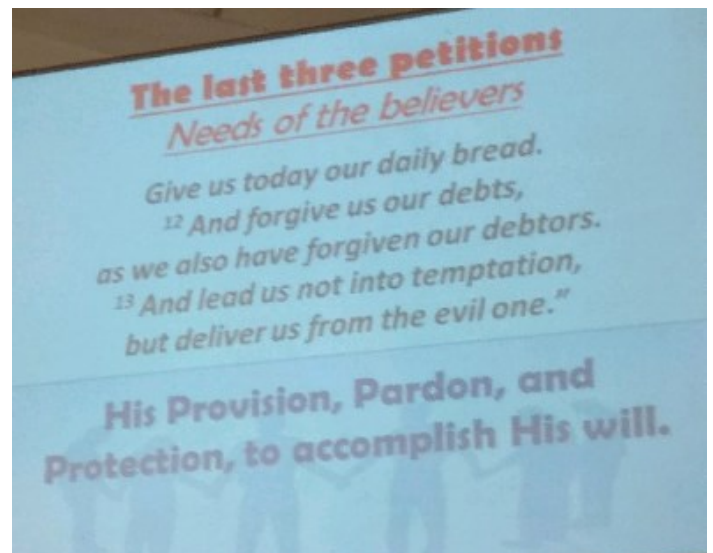
HIS KINGDOM - refers to HIS Reign



Third Petition - HIS Purpose



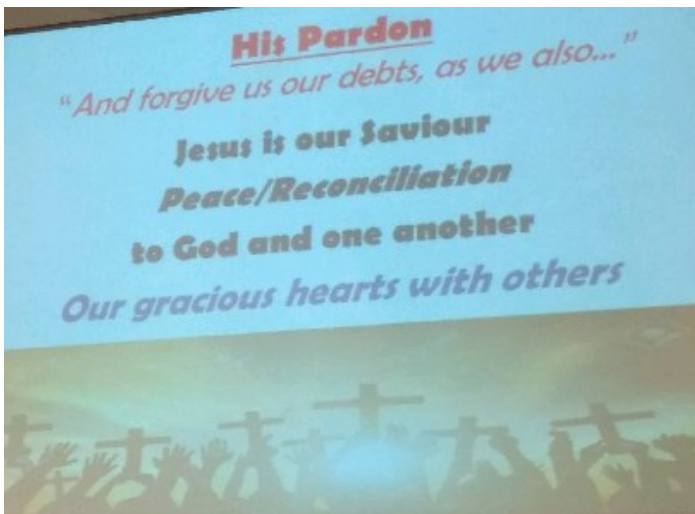

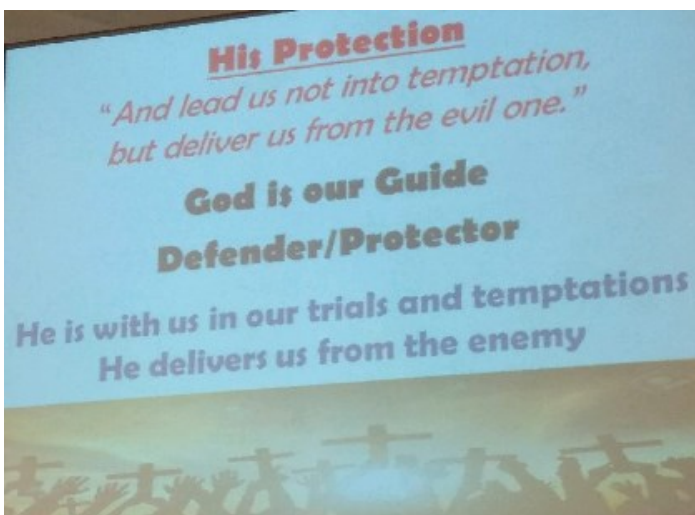
