1 The two angels arrived at Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gateway of the city. ..

2 "My lords," he said, "please turn aside to your servant's house. .....




4-5 Before they had gone to bed, all the men from every part of the city of Sodom both young and old—surrounded the house. They called to Lot, "Where are the men who came to you tonight? Bring them out to us so that we can have sex with them."

6-8 Lot went outside to meet them .., "No, *my friends*. Don't do this wicked thing. Look, I have two daughters who have never slept with a man. Let me bring them out to you, and you can do what you like with them. But don't do anything to these men, for they have come under the protection of my roof."

9-11, "Get out of our way," ".. we'll treat you worst than them" .. the men inside .. pulled Lot back .. struck the men ...with blindness.

12 The two men said to Lot, "Do you have anyone else here—sons-in-law, sons or daughters, or anyone else ..? Get them out of here,



14 So Lot went out and spoke to his sons-in-law, who were married to his daughters. He said, "Hurry and get out of this place, because the LORD is about to destroy the city!" But his sons-in-law thought he was joking.

17 As soon as they had brought them out, one of them said, "Flee for your lives! Don't look back, and don't stop anywhere in the plain! Flee to the mountains or you will be swept away!"

19-20 "... But I can't flee to the mountains; this disaster will overtake me, and I'll die. Look, here is a town near enough to run to, and it is small (Zoar). Let me flee to it.."

21 He said to him, "Very well, I will grant this request too; I will not overthrow the town you speak of.




24 Then the LORD rained down burning sulfur on Sodom and Gomorrah—from the LORD out of the heavens. Thus he overthrew those cities and the entire plain, destroying all those living in the cities—and also the vegetation in the land.

26 But Lot's wife looked back, and she became a pillar of salt.

29 So when God destroyed the cities of the plain, he remembered Abraham, and he brought Lot out of the catastrophe that overthrew the cities where Lot had lived.

30 Lot and his two daughters left Zoar and settled in the mountains, for he was afraid to stay in Zoar. .. lived in a cave.

31 One day the older daughter said to the younger, "Our father is old, and there is no man around here to give us children—as is the custom all over the earth.



32 Let's get our father to drink wine and then sleep with him and preserve our family line through our father."

36-38 So both of Lot's daughters became pregnant by their father. The older daughter had a son, and she named him Moab ; he is the father of the Moabites of today. The younger daughter also had a son, and she named him Ben-Ammi ; he is the father of the Ammonites of today.






# Bewildering behaviour of Lot's daughters
