
- Longest letter 7114 words.

His Credentials

Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God— 2 the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures ³ regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life was a descendant of David, ⁴ and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.




A Servant and an Apostle for the Gospel of the Trinitarian God, Son, Spirit.

Called by God

⁵ Through him we received grace and apostleship to call all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from faith for his name's sake. ⁶ And you also are among those Gentiles who are called to belong to Jesus Christ.

Appointed by grace and called to be apostle to the Gentiles



Greeting to the Christians

⁷ To all in Rome who are loved by God and called to be his holy people: Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ.

Both Jews and Gentiles Saints

Reconciled to God by His Grace



His Concern & Purpose

⁸ First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being reported all over the world. ⁹ God, whom I serve in my spirit in preaching the gospel of his Son, is my witness how constantly I remember you ¹⁰ in my prayers at all times; and I pray that now at last by God's will the way may be opened for me to come to you.

He thanked God for them and prayed for them




His Longing to Visit

For spiritual strengthening and mutual encouragement

¹¹ I long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong— 12 that is, that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith. 13 I do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, that I planned many times to come to you (but have been prevented from doing so until now) in order that I might have a harvest among you, just as I have had among the other Gentiles.

¹⁴ I am obligated both to Greeks and non-Greeks, both to the wise and the foolish. ¹⁵ That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are in Rome. ¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel...

Indebted and convicted to preach to both Greek and non-Greek




Reasons for Not Ashamed


Righteousnes Received and Lived Out by Faith

The Righteous Shall Live By Faith


What grace! What a relief!

Martin Luther

He wrote about his struggle with righteousness,

"I took it to mean that righteousness whereby God is righteous and acts righteously in punishing the unrighteous...



It was 1512, as he began to study Paul's Epistle to the Romans, that the verse "For in the Gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: the righteous will live by faith"
Romans 1:17.

Night and day I pondered until...I grasped the truth that the righteousness of God is that righteousness whereby through grace and sheer mercy, he justified us by faith.

Thereupon I felt myself to be reborn and to have gone through open door into paradise."

"A quarter before nine, I felt my heart strangely warmed. I felt I did trust in Christ, Christ alone, for salvation; and an assurance was given to me that He had taken away my sins, even mine, and saved me from the law of sin and death."
