
Temptations in His Kingdom

Disobedient vs. Obedient




First Temptation Physical Deprivation

When hungry and thirsty on the cross




Jesus defended himself with the Word of God

Death on the Cross



Satan quoted Ps. 91:11-12 to challenge Jesus

For <u>it is written</u>: "He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."

He missed out the verse

'to guard you in all your ways'

God promised both protection and prevention



Jesus Quoted Deut. 6:16 for his defend

No need to test God! As the Israelites did at Massah Exodus 17



Third Temptation

God's divine assignment to strengthen us




Power of His Word
