

<sup>14</sup> For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace.









# The law takes centre stage


Does it mean the law is not important in our new life?

### V1-6 The Authority of the Law

Do you not know, brothers and sisters – for I am speaking to those who know the law – that the law has authority over someone only as long as that person lives?

The law only applies/binding to those during their life



#### **A Marriage Metaphor**

For example, by law a married woman is bound to her husband as long as he is alive, but if her husband dies, she is released from the law that binds her to him.

Death releases our obligation to the law


'till death do us part'



# Through Baptism We died to the law

<sup>4</sup> So, my brothers and sisters, you also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God.


Through the church

### We are Delivered from the Law

<sup>6</sup> But now, by dying to what once bound us, we have been released from the law so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit, and not in the old way of the written code.

We are released from the law and joined to Christ for a new life of the Spirit

**Chapter 6** – You are not under the law.


**Chapter 7** – You are discharged from it.

#### Paul has cast a negative light on the law

- Chapter 2 It condemns and judges you.
- Chapter 3 It cannot justify or save you.
- Chapter 4 It brings wrath of God to you.
- Chapter 5 It makes people sin more.

#### Certainly not!




# V7-13 A Defence of the Law

#### **The Law Reveals Sin**

Nevertheless, I would not have known what sin was had it not been for the law. For I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, 'You shall not covet.'

Romans 3:20 "Through the law we become conscious of sin."

#### **The Law Provokes Sin**

<sup>8</sup> But sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, produced in me every kind of coveting. For apart from the law, sin was dead.

'Opportunity' Gk 'Aphorme',

for further advance.


Romans 4:15 "where there is no law there is no transgression."




#### **The Law Kills**

<sup>9</sup> Once I was alive apart from the law; but when the commandment came, sin sprang to life and I died...<sup>11</sup> For sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, deceived me, and through the commandment put me to death.

The law deceived and brought death and condemnation





# The law shows the sinfulness of sin

Nevertheless, in order that sin might be recognized as sin, it used what is good to bring about my death, so that through the commandment sin might become utterly sinful. It shows the true extent and the terrible nature of sin in us.

# The Law is *Holy, Righteous, and Good*

The law is not responsible for sin and death.

Our sinful nature is!

The law defines, reveals, and displays sin to bring us to Christ.



# V14-25 The Weakness of the Law

The law cannot save us or helps us to change for *good*.

The law is not responsible for our sin and death, but it cannot make us holy.




#### The Law is Spiritual

<sup>14</sup> We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin.

#### We are Unspiritual

We are sinful, carnal, slave to sin

A mortal body that sin attack



#### **The Wretched Man**

<sup>15</sup> I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do.

<sup>19</sup> For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do – this I keep on doing.

# An Inner Conflict His mind can't control the body




### The New Nature Delights in the Law

<sup>21</sup> So I find this law at work: although I want to do good, evil is right there with me. <sup>22</sup> For in my inner being I delight in God's law;

# The old nature delights in breaking the law

<sup>23</sup>but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me <u>a prisoner</u> of the law of sin at work within me.




#### He cries out for help

<sup>24</sup> What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death?

Not the Law. Not Himself.
