1. The Spirit Gives Boldness

*“Then Peter stood up with the Eleven,
raised his voice and addressed the crowd...”*

What Changed?

From Fear to Fearless

It's only nine in the morning!

He quoted Joel 2:28-32:

Pentecost is not chaos.

It is prophecy fulfilled.

Joel 2:28-32 This is That!

17 “In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people...¹⁸ Even on my servants...and they will prophesy...²¹ And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

**All will receive His Spirit and prophesy,
not only the elite**

Salvation is for ALL who believe

2. The Spirit Centres the Message on Jesus

*Men of Israel, listen to this:
“Jesus of Nazareth...”*

**Preach not about spiritual
experiences but Jesus himself**
Presented three truths
about Jesus:

*His Life, Death and
Resurrection, and Exaltation*



A. Jesus' Life Was God's Plan (v. 22-23)

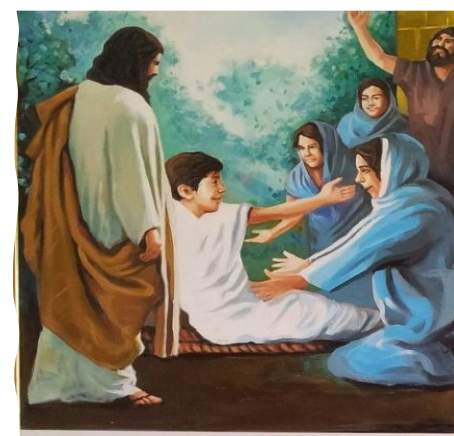
*A Man attested by God to you
by miracles, wonders, and signs*

**Jesus' miracles were public
evidence of divine approval**

His crucifixion - not accident

*"Delivered by God's deliberate
plan and foreknowledge."*

**The cross not a tragedy,
but redemption.**



"Arise"-And the dead man sat up and began to speak



"Because of your faith, you will be healed"



B. Jesus' Resurrection **Was God's Victory**

Peter boldly declares:

"God raised Him from the dead."

Death could not hold Him

David foresaw the resurrection

Peter quoted David Ps. 16:8-11

²⁵ David said about him: "I saw the Lord always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken



The Messiah's body would not decay

*27 because you will not abandon me
to the realm of the dead, you will
not let your holy one see decay.*

**David's tomb was still occupied
but Jesus' tomb was empty**

*The body that will not see decay
is that of the Messiah Jesus*

"We are Witnesses"

Resurrection is True!

C. Jesus' Exaltation Is God's Declaration

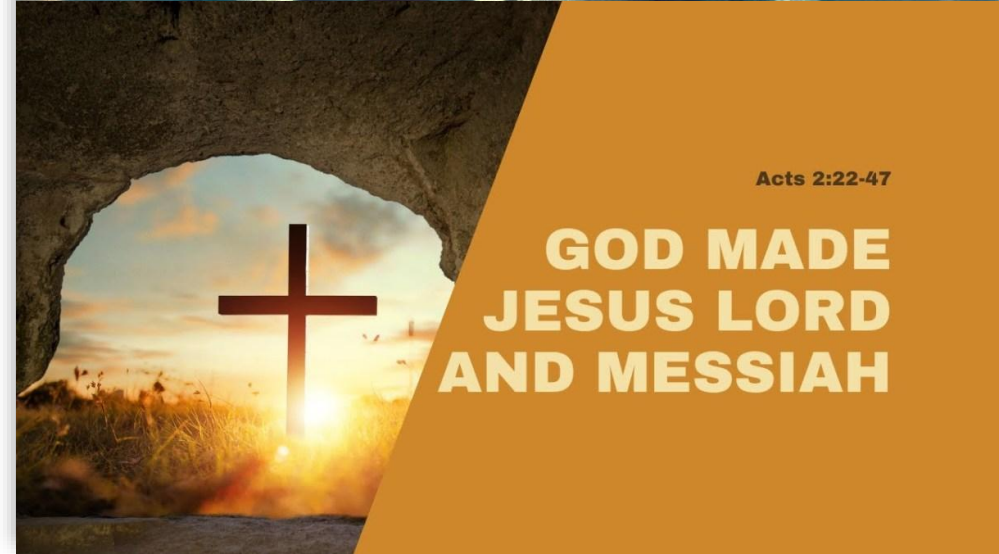
Peter quoted David Ps. 110:1

³⁴ For David did not ascend to heaven, and yet he said, "The Lord said to my Lord: 'Sit at my right hand ³⁵ until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet.'"

***Position of honour,
authority, power, and victory***

Jesus reigns in our life

**Jesus is the Lord
and Christ, the Messiah**

3. The Spirit Brings Conviction to Hearts

“When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart...”

Deep emotional spiritual piercing

Conversion follows Conviction

“Repent and be baptized...

in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”

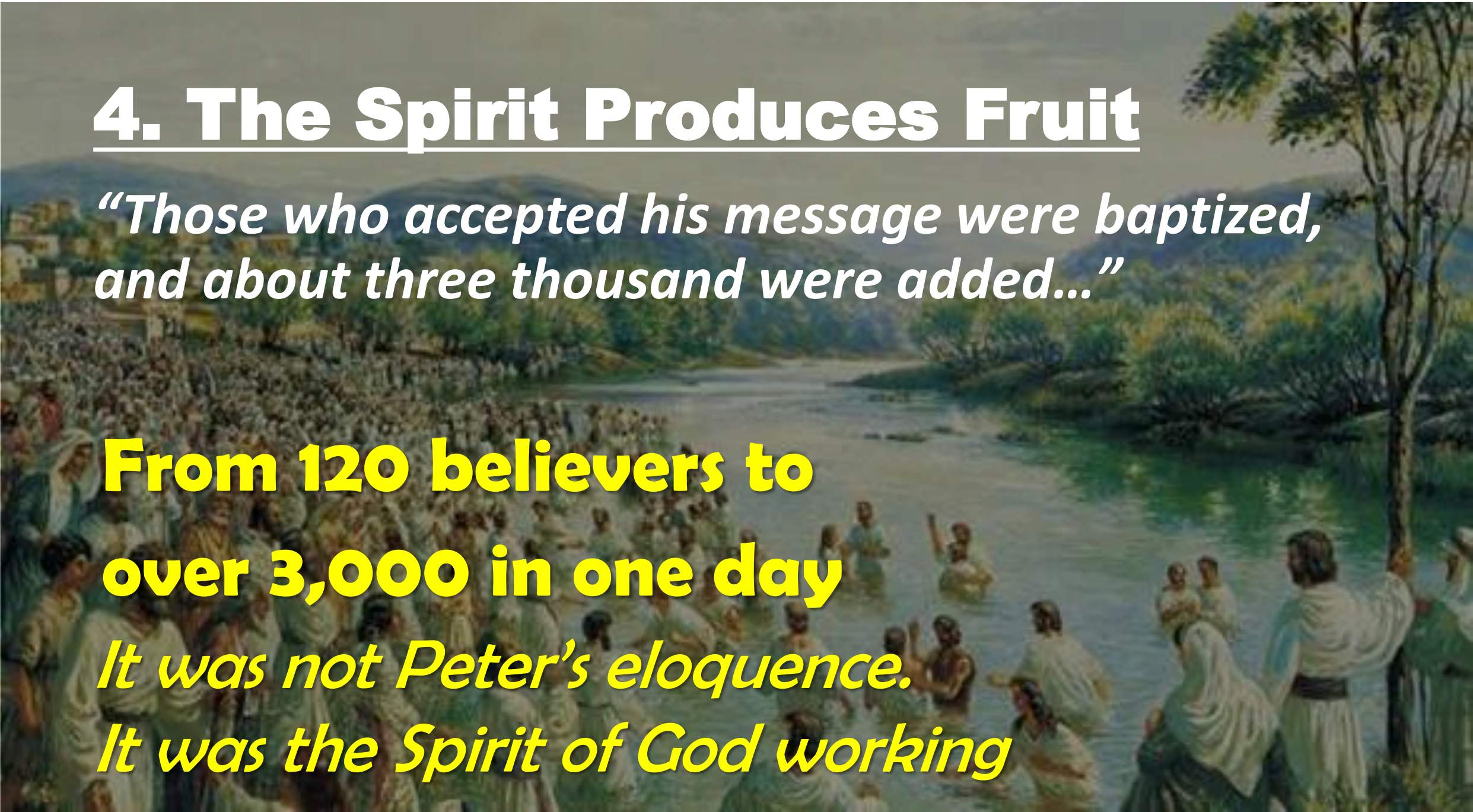
4. The Spirit Produces Fruit

“Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added...”

**From 120 believers to
over 3,000 in one day**

It was not Peter's eloquence.

It was the Spirit of God working





Acts 2:14-41 Spirit-Led Witness
From Waiting to Witnessing

When the Spirit Fills:

- ***Fear turns into boldness.***
- ***Confusion turns into clarity.***
- ***Indifference turns into conviction.***
- ***Crowds turn into converts.***

The Spirit Calls for a Response

*“Save yourselves from
this corrupt generation.”*

Great Reassurance

*The promise is for them,
their children, all who are far off*

Salvation is for ALL!

The Harvest is Plentiful!

*The same Holy Spirit who moved
in Jerusalem still moves today.*



Are you Witnessing for the Lord?

You may say: *“I am not a preacher.”*
“I am shy.” “I don’t know enough.”

The question is not:
*“Are you bold or able
but are you filled?”*

Peter once said,
“I don’t know the man.”
Now filled with the Spirit said,
“God has made this Jesus Lord.”



Be Spirit-filled Witness

- 1. The Spirit Gives Boldness**
- 2. Centres the Message on Jesus**
- 3. Brings Conviction to Hearts**
- 4. The Spirit bears fruits**

When the Spirit leads:

Fear decreases.

Clarity increases.

Opportunity opens.



A Freeing Truth for us:

The Spirit convicts people

We do not convert people

Faithfulness is ours.

Fruitfulness is His.

Our responsibility:

Speak clearly, truthfully, lovingly.

The Spirit's responsibility:

Open hearts. Draw sinners. Convict.



How Do We Witness Being Filled/Led by the Spirit?

1. Pray for Filling

2. Speak When Prompted

3. Stay Rooted in Scripture

Share Christ, His life, The cross, The resurrection, The Lordship of Christ.

4. Trust the Spirit for Results

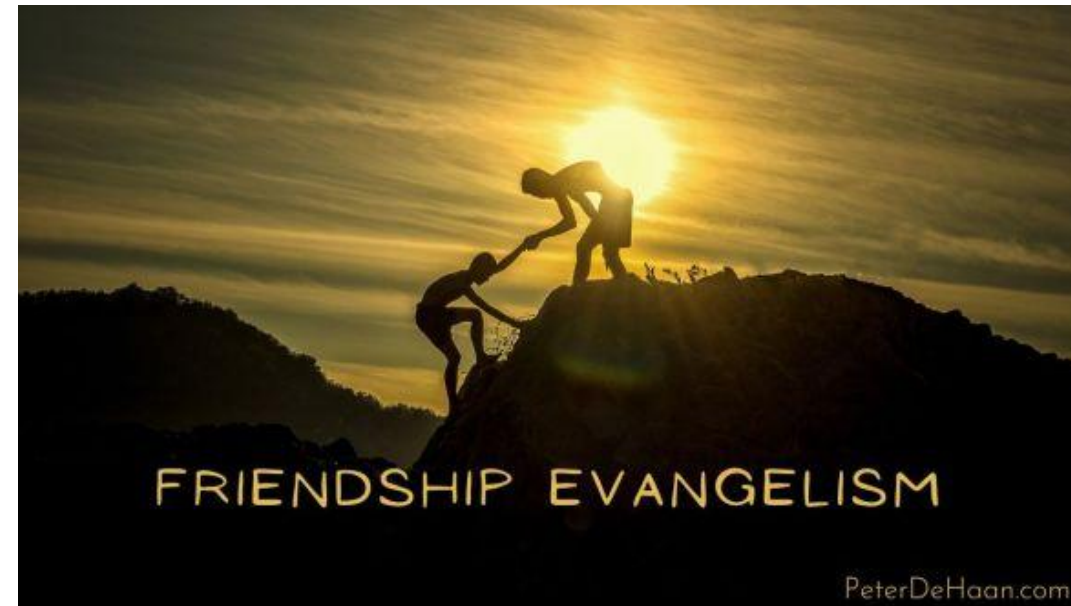
