



QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION: ON SERMON III – A Letter to the Seven Churches (Rev 2:12 – 3:6)

1. *Both the churches in Pergamum and Thyatira were led astray by false teachings and have compromised their life and worship of God, what are some false teachings and compromises you see in the church today?*

2. *If Jesus were to come to Holy Light and give his assessment of the church in terms of her teaching and lifestyle, what do you think how her report card will look like?*

3. *Do you see any false teachings and compromises that have come to Holy Light?
How can we stand up to such false teachings and compromises?*

4. *The Sardis church was diagnosed to be a ‘dynamic’ but dying church. They look good on the outside with church activities practicing a form of godliness but devoid of its power. What would be some warning signs to look out for in a church that is exhibiting this feature?*

5. *George Ladd shared on a picture of Nominal Christianity today,*

“Here is a picture of nominal Christianity, outwardly prosperous, busy with externals of religious activity, but devoid of spiritual life and power.”

How much of this picture is reflective of Holy Light congregation?

What are some precautions we can take to avoid or correct this?
