

Matt 9:18-34 Jesus His Trustworthiness

Jesus raised a dead girl and healed a sick woman
Jesus healed the blind and the mute

Regardless of the kind of faith in him!



Jesus raised a dead girl

¹⁸ While he was saying this, a synagogue leader came and knelt before him and said, 'My daughter has just died. But come and put your hand on her, and she will live.'

¹⁹ Jesus got up and went with him, and so did his disciples...



Jesus restored her to life

²³ When Jesus entered the synagogue leader's house and saw the noisy crowd and the people playing pipes, ²⁴ he said, 'Go away. The girl is not dead but asleep.'

But they laughed at him.


²⁵ After the crowd had been put outside, he went in and took the girl by the hand, and she got up.

Jesus is trustworthy in the face of scorn and slander



Jesus healed a sick woman

²⁰ Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak. ²¹ She said to herself, 'If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed.'



Jesus healed and saved her

Jesus turned and saw her. 'Take heart, daughter,' he said, 'your faith has healed you.

And the woman was healed at that moment.

Jesus is trustworthy even when interrupted by the unclean, outcast.



Jesus healed the blind

As Jesus went on from there, two blind men followed him, calling out, 'Have mercy on us, Son of David!'

28 When he had gone indoors, the blind men came to him, and he asked them, 'Do you believe that I am able to do this?' 'Yes, Lord,' they replied.

A Messianic Faith



Jesus gave them sight

²⁹ Then he touched their eyes and said, 'According to your faith let it be done to you'; ³⁰ and their sight was restored.

In line with their faith



Jesus healed the demon-possessed mute

While they were going out, a man who was demon-possessed and could not talk was brought to Jesus. ³³ And when the demon was driven out, the man who had been mute spoke.

Because of someone else's faith

The crucial element is not the strength of our faith but the trustworthiness of Jesus




The question is: How do we respond to Jesus?
