Colossians 1:28 - 2:10

Introduction

- Colossians.. troubled by false teachings which threaten their faith.
- Salvation : faith in Christ plus 'secret knowledge' and human regulations (circumcision, eating and dinking and observance of religious festivals)

Paul's goal for them:

- Fully mature in Christ....to counter the heresy
- Gives them 'strategic plans' to achieve this



Colossians 1:28-2:2

- He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ.
- To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me.

I want you to know how hard I am contending for you and for those at Laodicea, and for all who have not met me personally. ² My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding... Christ,

The goal of Paul's labor

- present everyone <u>fully</u> <u>mature in Christ</u>.(1:28)
- have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they <u>may know the</u> <u>mystery of God, namely,</u> <u>Christ, ³ in whom are hidden all</u> the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. (2:2-3)

Fully mature in Christ


- Depends on a complete understanding /knowledge of Christ
- Not be shaken by false teachings...stable faith

He is the One.....

He is the one we proclaim admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ.

He is the Supreme Christ





To this end..... I strenuously contend

strenuously contend......

- labor, striving (Amplified BV)
- work hard, doing my best (Message)
- Not a stroll in the park, but a priority to work hard for.

Problems faced.... False teachings

- ⁴ I tell you this so that no one may <u>deceive</u> you by fine-sounding arguments
- ⁸ See to it that no one <u>takes you</u> <u>captive</u> through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ.

Fine-sounding arguments

 Deny Christ as the sufficient saviorthey claim to have the 'secret knowledge' for salvation

Hollow philosophy

¹⁶ Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day. ¹⁷ These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ. ¹⁸ Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you. Such a person also goes into great detail about what they have seen; they are puffed up with idle notions by their unspiritual mind.

- Jewish mythologies:
- mixture of rituals and belief in angels (2:16-18)

Colossians 2:20-23

²⁰ Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as though living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations -21"Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle," ²²which all concern things which perish with the using – according to the commandments and doctrines of **men**? ²³These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in **self-imposed** religion, false humility, and neglect of the body, but are of no value against the indulgence of the flesh.

- Not subject to them as we have died with Christ to them
- No true spiritual value

Galatians 1:6-7

⁶ I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you to live in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel—⁷ which is really no gospel at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the gospel of Christ.

- False teachings ...pervert the gospel of Christ.
- Danger of turning from the true gospel.
- 'no gospel' false assurance of salvation.

Problems faced....

 False teachings ... seek to derail their faith

Caused:

- Discouragement of heart
- Disunity

'they may be encouraged in heart and united in love'

Disunity: factions

¹⁰ I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought.

(1 Corinthians 1: 10-13)

¹² What I mean is this: One of you says, "I follow Paul"; another, "I follow Apollos"; another, "I follow Cephas"; still another, "I follow Christ."

¹³ Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Were you baptized in the name of Paul?

How to grow into maturity?

- Obedience to Christ as Lord
- Rooted and built up in Word

Growth: Starting point


- ⁶ So then, just as you <u>received</u> <u>Christ Jesus as Lord, continue</u> <u>to live</u> your lives in him,
- Christ as Lord..... Obedience to Him only.
- Not only Savior but Lord and King

Galatians 2:20 (NIV)




Lord over the whole of our life, not only part of it

Growth: built up in faith



double metaphor for growth

- Downwards: Roots grow deep into the soil /foundation
- Upward: depends on good 'rooting'/ strong foundation

Growth: How?

- as you were taught....Word
- overflowing with thankfulness.

Spiritual growth come by:

- Hearing (studying) /obeying the Word..
- Lead to strengthening of faith

Word of God.. appropriate weapon

The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ. 2 Corinthians 10:4-5

Spiritual battles:

- Strongholds : mindsets and beliefs against the knowledge of God which are difficult to overcome
- Word...weapon as used by Jesus (Matthew 4)



- Word ...sword of the Spirit
- Fight spiritual battles.
- Prayer....power behind the weapons


Do not be anxious:

Everything we might want to ask about God and His purposes can and must now be answered with reference to the crucified and risen Jesus, the Messiah. (N T Wright)


Brought to fullness

Intimate knowledge of Christ



- I want to know Christ ... the power of His resurrection (3:10)


Maturity: know the Word


Goal to work for

Growth is from God






Victory over


- Discouragement at home, school, office or even in church
