



Jesus' Power and Authority to Heal

- V1-4 Jesus healed a man with leprosy
- V5-13 Jesus healed the centurion's servant

- V16-17 A conclusion: Jesus heals many



Jesus healed a man with leprosy

When Jesus came down from the mountainside, large crowds followed him. ² A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, 'Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean.'

A Jewish Leprosy Sufferer

The suffering is physical, social, and spiritual



Jesus touched and healed

³ Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. '<u>I am willing</u>,' he said. '<u>Be clean</u>!' Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy.

An Extraordinary Loving Act!

His compassion and love to heal

Not a question of ability but of willingness and compassion




Restoration to Fellowship and Worship

⁴ Then Jesus said to him, 'See that you don't tell anyone. But go, show yourself to the priest and offer the gift Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.'

He was healed completely

Physically, Socially, and Spiritually

The Law of the Leper (Leviticus 13-14)



16. Shall dip them and the living bird in the blood (Lev. 14:6).

Jesus healed the centurion's servant

⁵ When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to him, asking for help.

⁶ 'Lord,' he said, 'my servant lies at home paralysed, suffering terribly.'

Healing is for ALL

The centurion humbled himself to come to Jesus because of his love for his servant and his faith in Jesus




His Faith in Jesus

⁸ The centurion replied, 'Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed. 9 For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, "Go," and he goes; and that one, "Come," and he comes. I say to my servant, "Do this," and he does it.

> Jesus' Authority is Equal to the Father





Faith and Healing

¹³ Then Jesus said to the centurion, 'Go! Let it be done just as you believed it would.'

And his servant was healed at that moment.

Faith is a key to healing power NOT healing is proportionate to or because of the man's faith

Ask, Believe, Receive


Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law spontaneously

¹⁴ When Jesus came into Peter's house, he saw Peter's mother-in-law lying in bed with a fever.

¹⁵ He touched her hand and the fever left her, and she got up and began to wait on him.

His readiness to heal for daily need of health to work

¹⁷ This was to fulfil what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: 'He took up our infirmities and bore our diseases.'

The 'Already and Not Yet'




Jesus Our Healer Seek Him to heal us and others in times of sickness and brokenness
