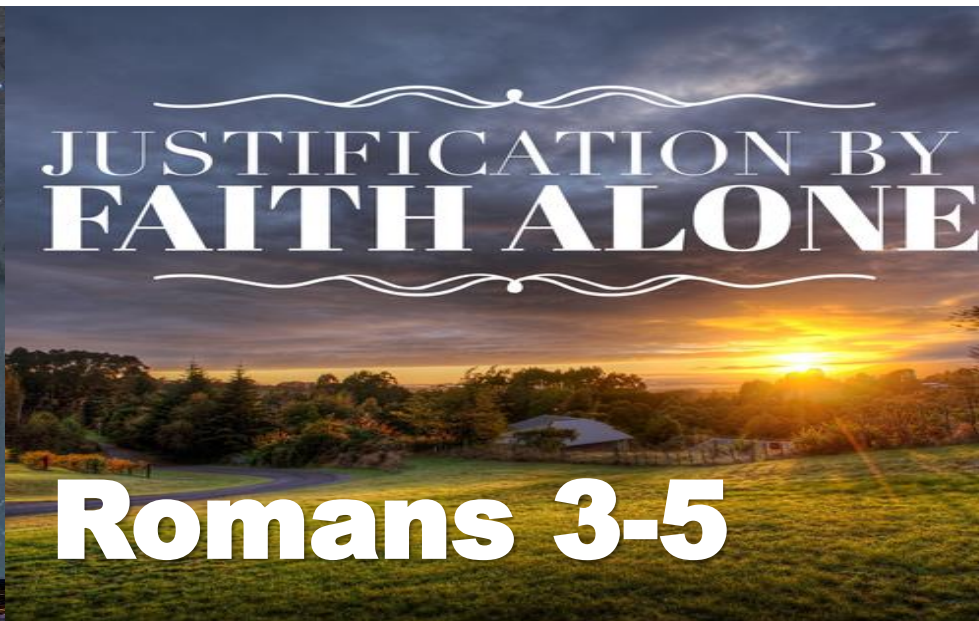

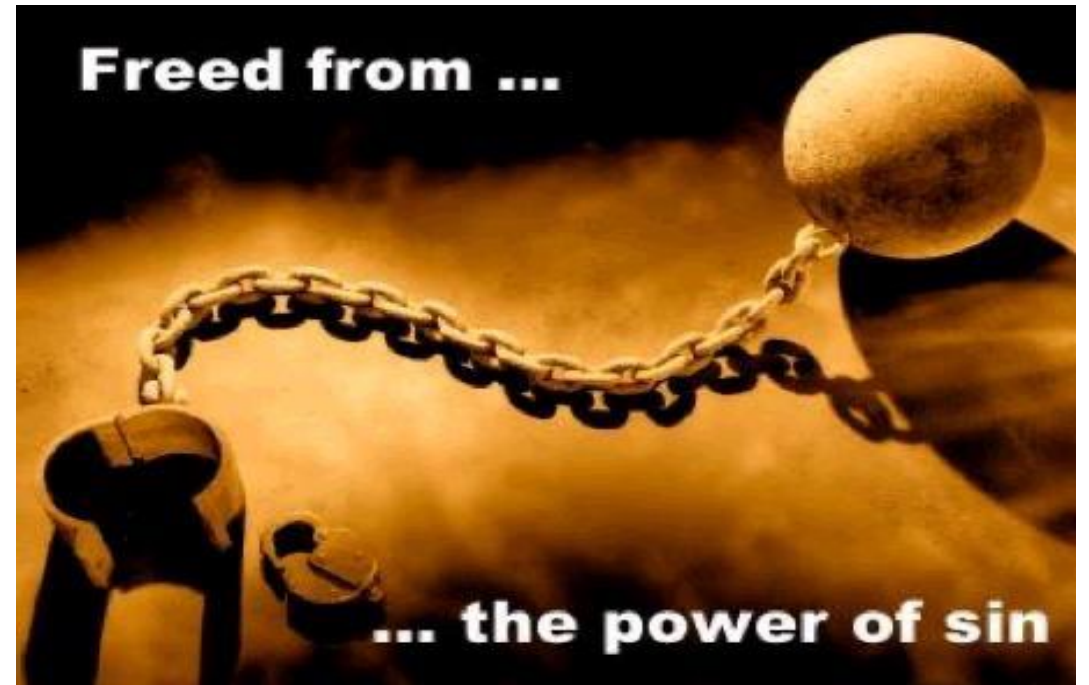

Our identification with Christ in his death, burial, and resurrection

Three Areas

- **V2-10** *Know in The mind*
- **V11** *Count in The Heart*
- **V12-14** *Yield in The Will*



Baptism signifies our union with Christ

³ Or don't you know that all of us who were baptised into Christ Jesus were baptised into his death? ⁴ We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

Alive with Him for a new life***



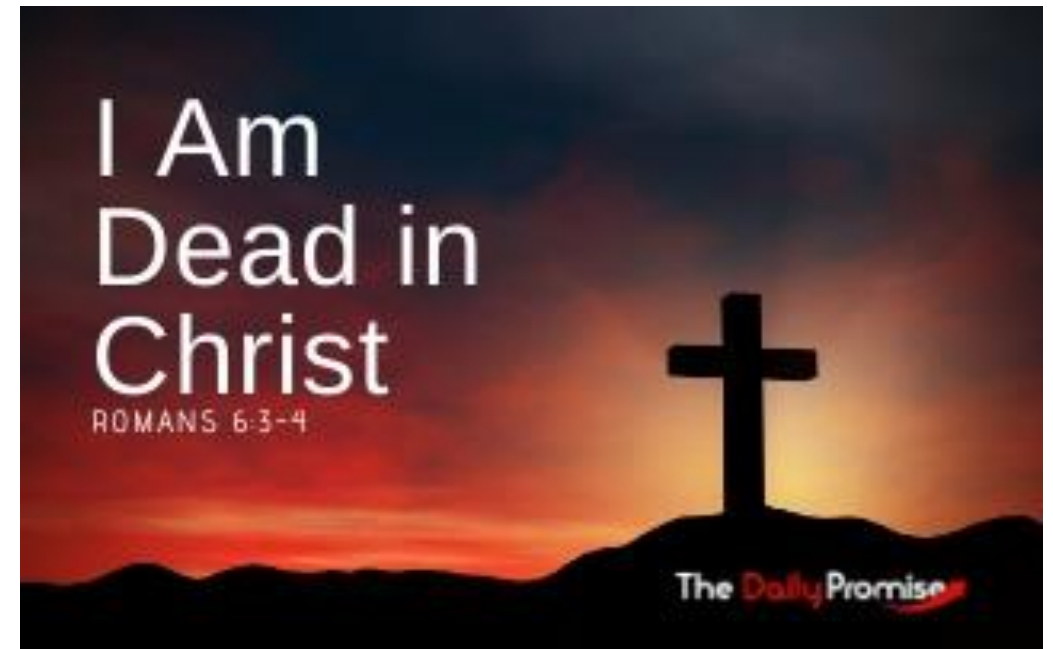
Our old self was crucified with Christ

⁶ For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin – ⁷ because anyone who has died has been set free from sin.

Set free from sin's power

Penalty paid for and finished

**Sin has no effect on
the one who has died**



Our new self was raised with Christ

⁸ Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹ For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. ¹⁰ The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God.

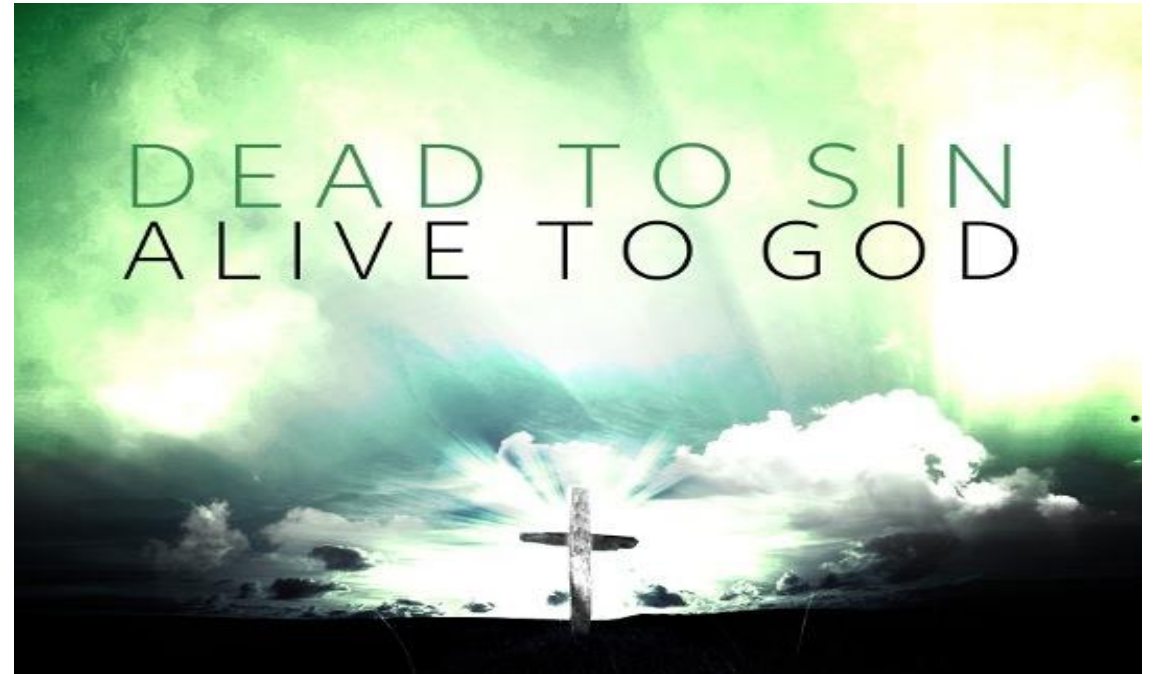
*His death is once and for all,

COUNT in the Heart

¹¹ In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

*Count, reckon, consider,
regard, look upon.*

OFFER, SURRENDER **YIELD in the Will**

¹² Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. ¹³ Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.

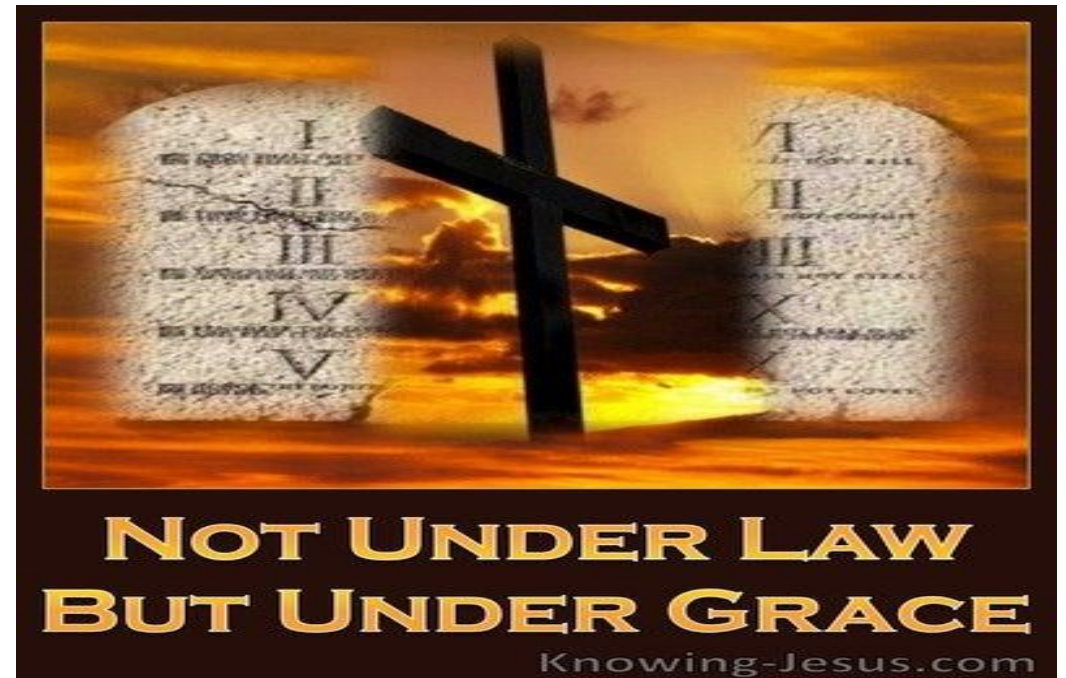


Sin is no longer our master

¹⁶ Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obey – whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness? ¹⁸ You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness.

**Self-surrender
leads to slavery**



**This voluntary slavery
has great benefits!**

²² But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. ²³ For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

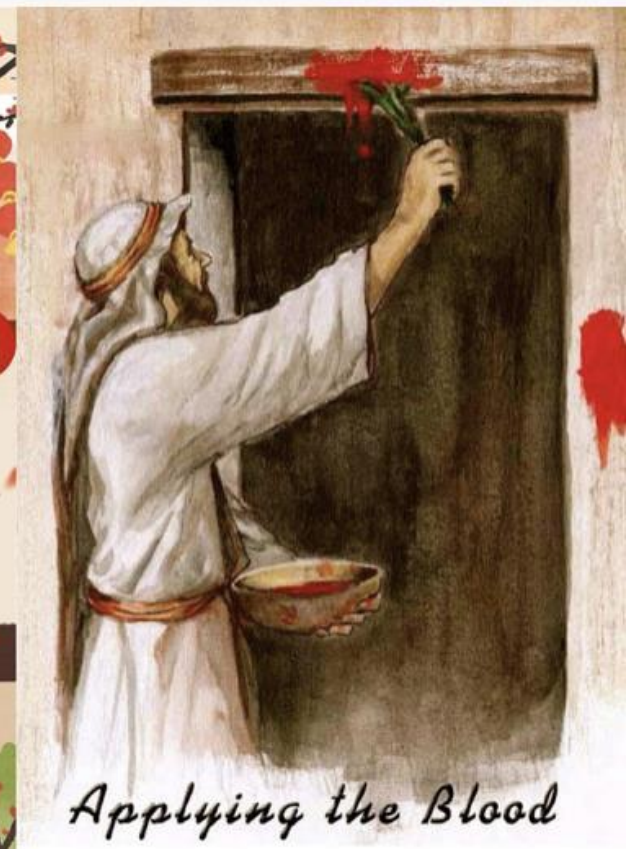

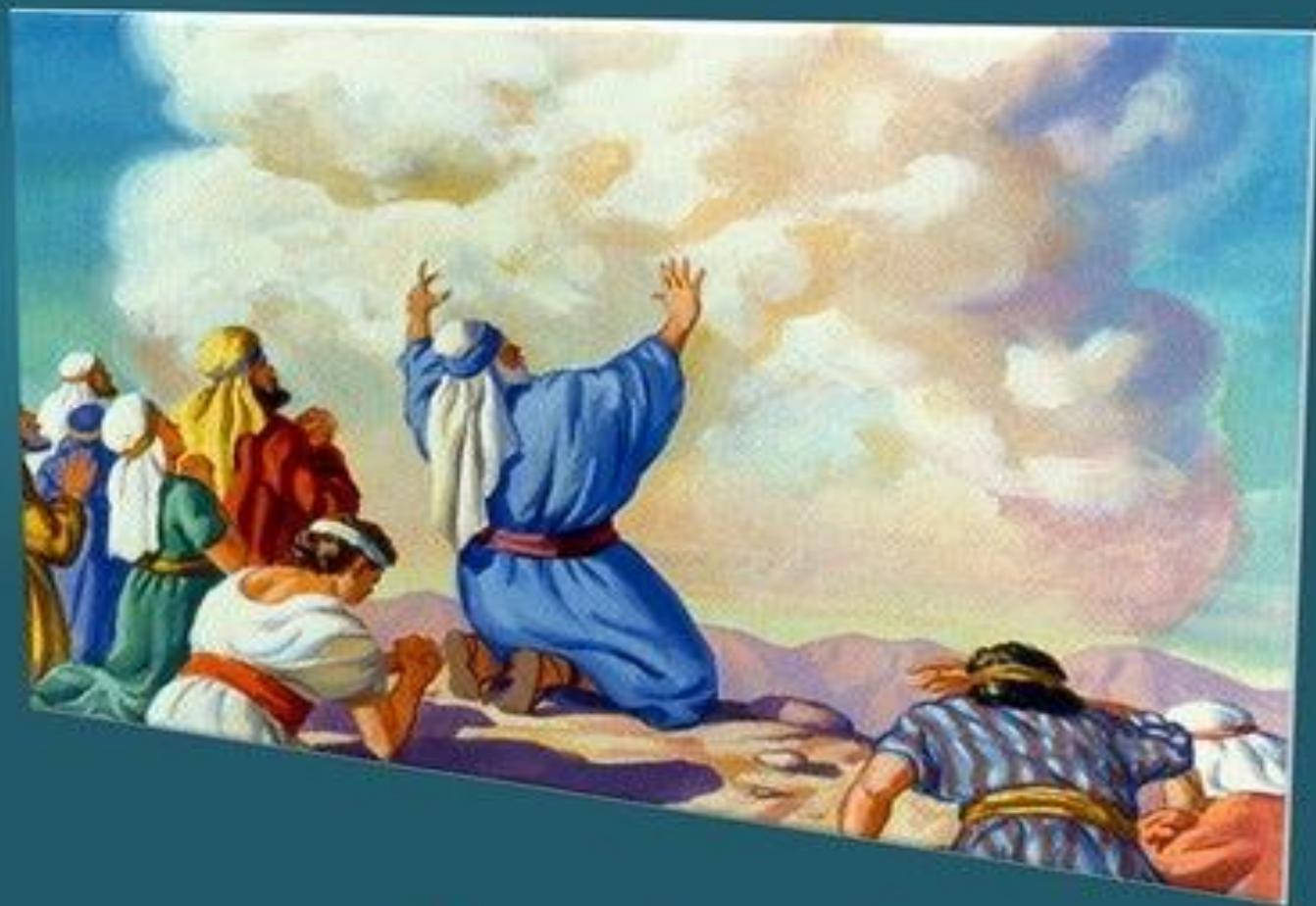
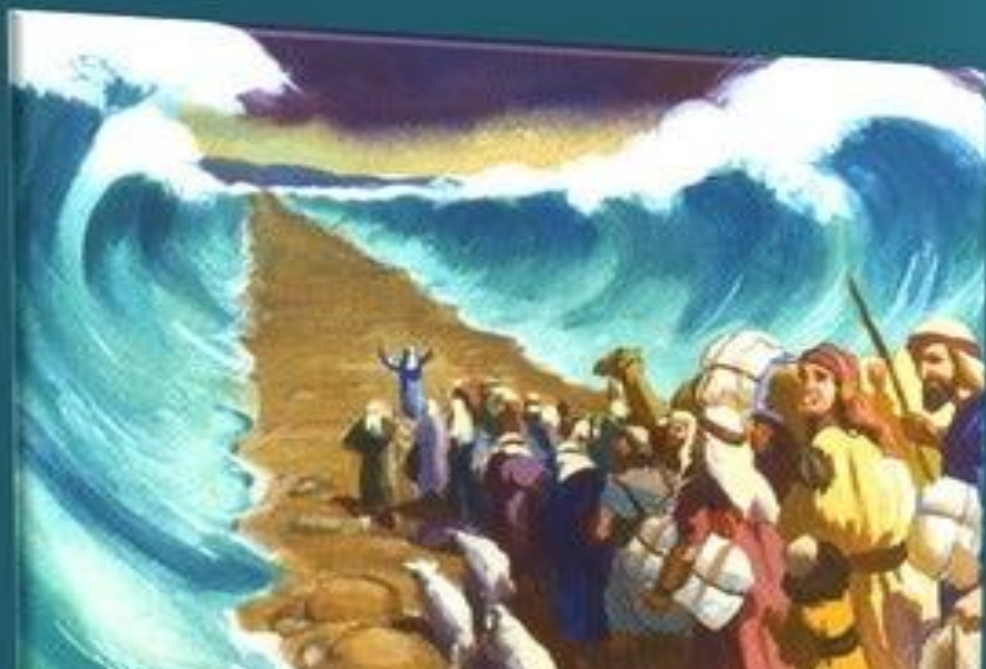
