#### LAMENTATIONS

- Meaning A passionate expression of griefs, sorrows; weeping
- Written by prophet Jeremiah during the time the Babylonian invasion and subsequent destruction of Solomon's temple around 586BC.
- As he walked through the streets of Jerusalem he saw nothing but pain, suffering and total destruction of a once great nation.
- In the 5 chapters, he listed among other things:
- Young men and women killed by the swords(2:21),
- Children begging food (2:12) and
- Formerly compassionate mothers eating their children (4:10)

Yet in the midst of a troubled, depressing and a seemingly hopeless situation, we read Lamentations 3:22-24

The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases. His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Thy faithfulness. "The LORD is my portion", says my soul," therefore I will hope in Him".


