# LAMENTATIONS

- Meaning - A passionate expression of griefs, sorrows; weeping
- Written by prophet Jeremiah during the time the Babylonian invasion and subsequent destruction of Solomon's temple around 586BC.
- As he walked through the streets of Jerusalem he saw nothing but pain, suffering and total destruction of a once great nation.
- In the 5 chapters, he listed among other things :
  - Young men and women killed by the swords(2:21),
  - Children begging food (2:12) and
  - Formerly compassionate mothers eating their children (4:10)

Yet in the midst of a

situation, we read  
Lamentations 3:22-24

The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases. His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Thy faithfulness. “The LORD is my portion”, says my soul, “therefore I will hope in Him”.

# NEW EVERY MORNING

- His steadfast love never ceases

(chesed) **חֶסֶד** - kindness, favor, mercy, beauty, goodness

- His mercies never come to an end

(racham) **רַחֵם** - compassion, tender love, great mercy, pity, womb

- Great is His faithfulness

(emunah) **אֱמוּנָה** steadfastness, firm in adherence to, loyal, true
