
Am I living my life for Christ?

To live for Christ



Partnership with God:

- more like Christ
- spread the gospel.

Correct motivation:

 Christ must be preached, exalted and boasted

Life for Christ must be consistent

• ²⁷ Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel ²⁸ without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but that you will be saved—and that by God.

Consistency means

- Daily conduct should be worthy of the gospel of Christ...lived for God, not for men
- From the heart, not hypocritical

- Persevere in suffering
- A privilege to share in Christ suffering as Paul was (29-30)


Unity is key

Consistent conduct in relationship



• Impact how we relate to one another.



Do not be selfish or proud in our relationship

Be humble with one another

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, Philippians 2:3

 Paul is dealing with disagreement (4:3)

Our actions should:

- Selfless (in ambition)
- Self humbling

Genesis 13:8-9

8 So Abram said to Lot, "Let's not have any quarreling between you and me, or between your herdsmen and mine, for we are brothers. 9 Is not the whole land before you? Let's part company. If you go to the left, I'll go to the right; if you go to the right, I'll go to the left."

Abram said to List: "Lleuse, there should be no quarreligg between me and you and between my herdunen and your herdunen, for me are brothers." Genesis 188.3



Example of selflessness

- Abram was selfless with Lot, his nephew....even though it was his right to take the first choice
- He trusted God to fulfill His promise despite not claiming his right to first choice

Selfish ambition or pride

- Is the pattern of the world...
- Workplace or institution...promotion is based on merit or favoritism
- Prioritize time and energy for work...to get our ambition
- At the expense of God, family and self (health)

Danger for us

- We prioritize work and claim it is for God, but the reality...
- We lack trust in God for the promotion or business contract

Instead, we should:


- Prioritize God first
- Trust Him to prosper us...despite the restricted time and opportunity

Another danger

- Obsessed with claiming our rights and blessings as God's children.
- ambition... for God to bless us and family

 We think:
 God's chief purpose is to please us and bless us.

Selfless ambition....



 The chief end of man is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever



I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage that I may gain Christ.

Philippians 3:8

- Rejected his heritage as a Benjamite Jew, position as a Pharisee and his zeal ...
- to gain Christ... his ambition

Value others above yourselves

- Consider others better than yourself
- Pride places self before others but humility, others before self

- Do not judge because we cannot judge fairly (Romans 2:1-3)
- Beware of the Pharisee in us... prone to judge out of spiritual pride

Value others above yourselves

 Value their opinions.... be quick to listen

- Give credit and praise freely when due... to encourage growth
- Failure... be gracious



- Natural to tend to our interest.....
- Commanded to put the interest of others at least on par with your own.
- Love your neighbor as yourself

Consider the interest of others

 Clash of interest is inevitable...need to put the other's interest first

- trust God for your own interests when you consider others
- Trust God to ensure you will not lose out.

Mindset of Christ....His example

⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: ⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; ⁷ rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.


Relationships: mindset of Christ

- Sacrificial
- Obedient
- Restorative

Sacrificial

- set aside His Glory and Majesty as God
- lowered himself... become a human servant
- He looked to our interest and lowered himself to serve us.

Considered our interest



- Love sacrificially
- Love practically: Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth (1 John 3:18)

Humble and obedient

- Born and lived in poverty.
- Rejected by His own people.
- Suffered cruelly at the hands of enemies and died a cruel death...the cross.

For us He

- removed the power of sin
- removed the barrier and restored us to God

Restorative

God restored his Majesty and Glory...

- exalted him..
- every knee will bow to His Name

PHILIPPIANS 2:9-11

Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, Ephesians 2:6 ESV

In Christ...we have an exalted position.(Eph 2:6)

 Can live sacrificially and obediently from an exalted position
