



QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION ON SERMON: Be Ready at All Time

2 Peter 3:10-12

¹⁰ But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything done in it will be laid bare.

¹¹ Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives

¹² as you look forward to the day of God and speed its coming. That day will bring about the destruction of the heavens by fire, and the elements will melt in the heat.

1. The pandemic has brought a new normal to our life, how will it affect your daily life especially your worship of God? What are some ways we can continue to worship God in spirit and truth?

2. The Bible is clear of Jesus' coming again and we are to be ready when he comes. How can we be ready for his coming again? Why is it urgent and important to be so?

2 Peter 1:5-7 ⁵ For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; ⁶ and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; ⁷ and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love.

3. Peter gave the believers a key in 2 Peter 1:5-7 to live the godly life intentionally with the 7-fold virtues to grow spiritually as they face challenges in their life. How can we apply this teaching as we face the pandemic and new normal in the coming days?



4. The attitude of eagerness of waiting for Jesus' return serves as an upward motivation for us to persevere to live the holy and godly life in times of challenges and troubles. Have you gone through any experience where this motivation of heaven has become real and helpful or are you going through challenges in your life now where you see this motivation will be useful? Share your thought and experience.

6. What do you understand as God's call for you in this pandemic to be ready for his return? Are there any areas of your life you need to take a step of faith and make adjustments in respond to this call? Share your thoughts and plans with the group.
