GENESIS 3

- 1 Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "**Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?**"
- 2 The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden,

9 But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?"

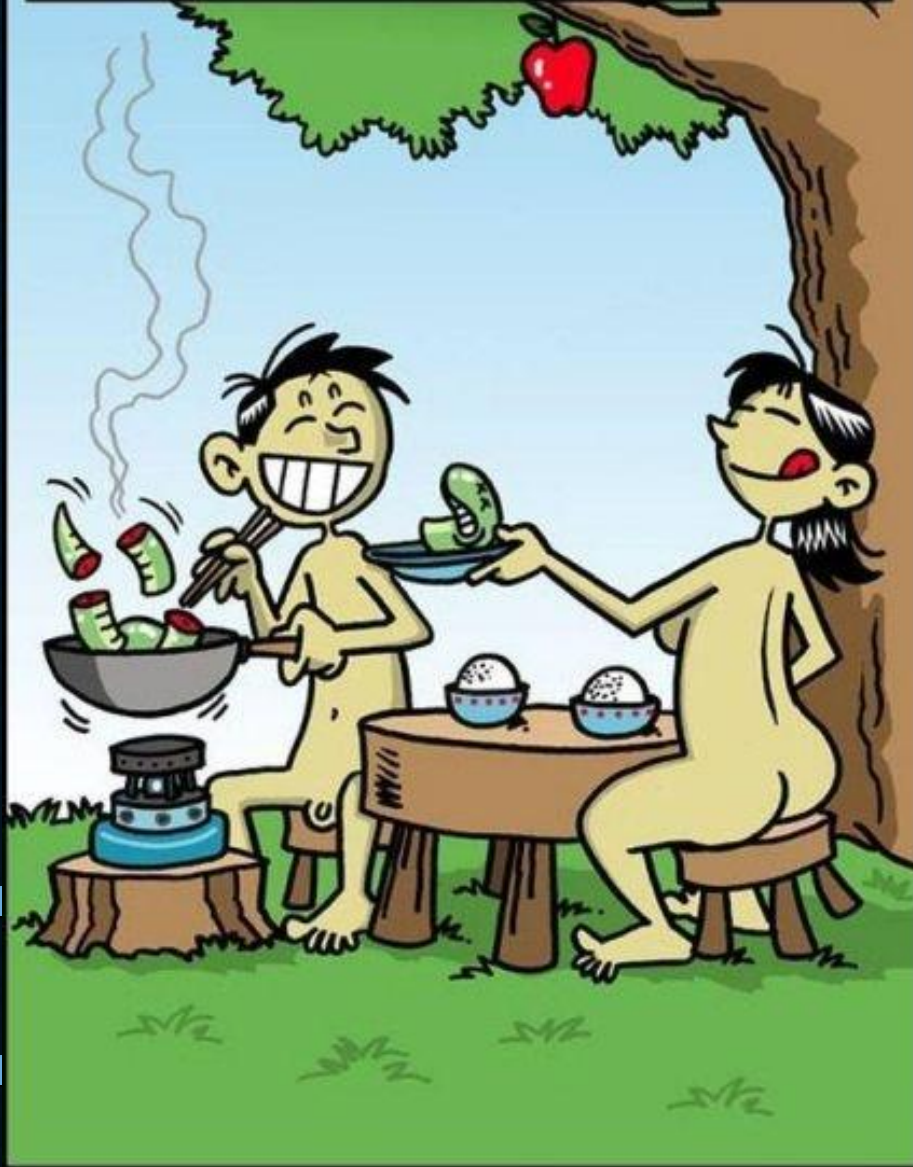
10 He answered, "I heard you in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid."
