
CALLED OUT OF HIDING



GENESIS 3


- 1 Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"
- 2 The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden,
- 3 but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.' "
- 4 "You will not surely die," the serpent said to the woman.

- 6 When the woman <u>saw</u> that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she <u>took</u> some and <u>ate</u> it. She also <u>gave</u> some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it.
- 7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves.
- 8 Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden.

- 9 But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?"
- 10 He answered, "I heard you in the garden, and I was <u>afraid</u> because I was <u>naked</u>; so I hid."
- 11 And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree that I commanded you not to eat from?"
- 12 The man said, "The woman you put here with me--she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it."
- 13 Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."


