"He will not see what happens to us."







The Lord is strengthening Jeremiah for more difficult times ahead




Future challenges for Jeremiah

 - make and wear a yoke of wood Babylonians will enslave Judah





- pastor of Westminster Chapel in London from 1904 to 1919, and from 1933 to 1943
