



- 10.Retirement (45).



Divorce and Co-habitation on the rise




#### The church is not spared

#### **Matthew 19:1-12**

When Jesus had finished saying these things, he left Galilee and went into the region of Judea to the other side of the Jordan. <sup>2</sup> Large crowds followed him, and he healed them there. <sup>3</sup> Some Pharisees came to him to test him. They asked, 'Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any and every reason?'

<sup>4</sup> 'Haven't you read,' he replied, 'that at the beginning the Creator "made them male and female," <sup>5</sup> and said, "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh"? <sup>6</sup>So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate.'


10 The disciples said to him, 'If this is the situation between a husband and wife, it is better not to marry.'




# A Covenant of Grace and Unconditional Love Not a Contract

- Some chose that way for God For kingdom work priority




### Marriage and Singleness are Both Gifts from God

Take it as a great calling like Paul


If you are single or divorced
