A Spirit-led Church: *See, Point, Call*

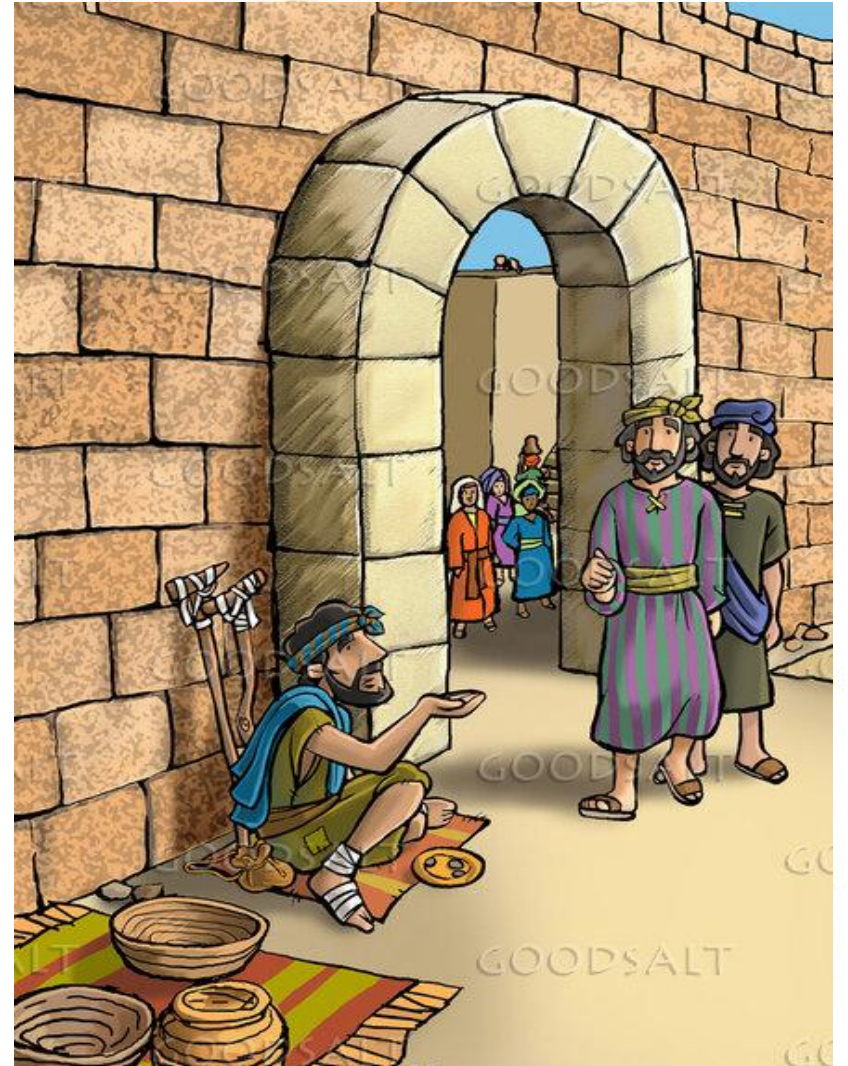
- 1. See and respond to human needs*
- 2. Point people clearly to Jesus*
- 3. Call people to repentance and new life*

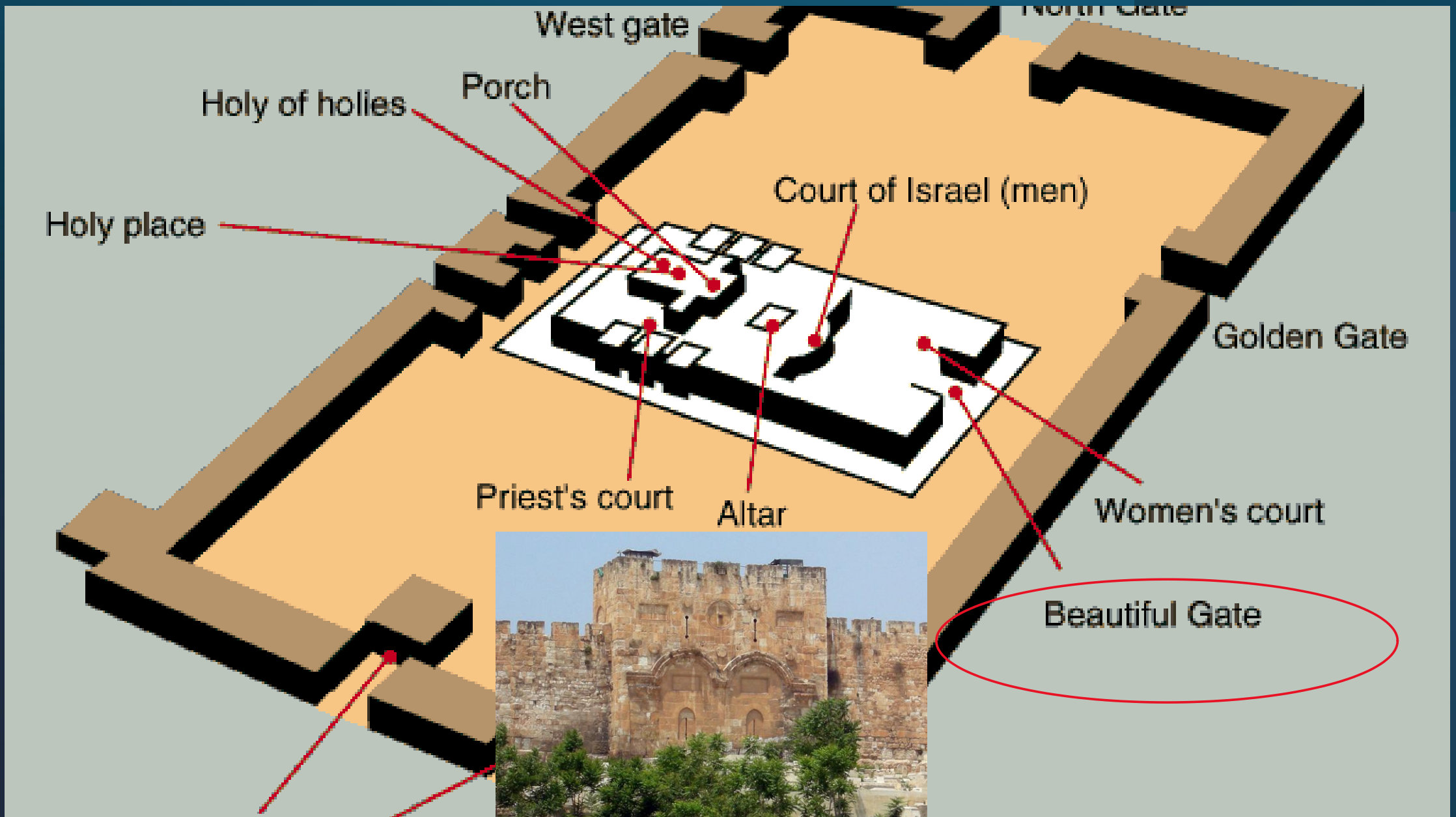
1. See Needs with His Compaasion

One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the time of prayer – at three in the afternoon.

² Now a man who was lame from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts.

A Spirit-Empowered Compassion

Peter said: *“Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you...”*

“In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.”



A Spirit-Empowered Action

⁷ Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong. He jumped to his feet and began to walk. Then he went with them into the temple courts, walking and jumping, and praising God.

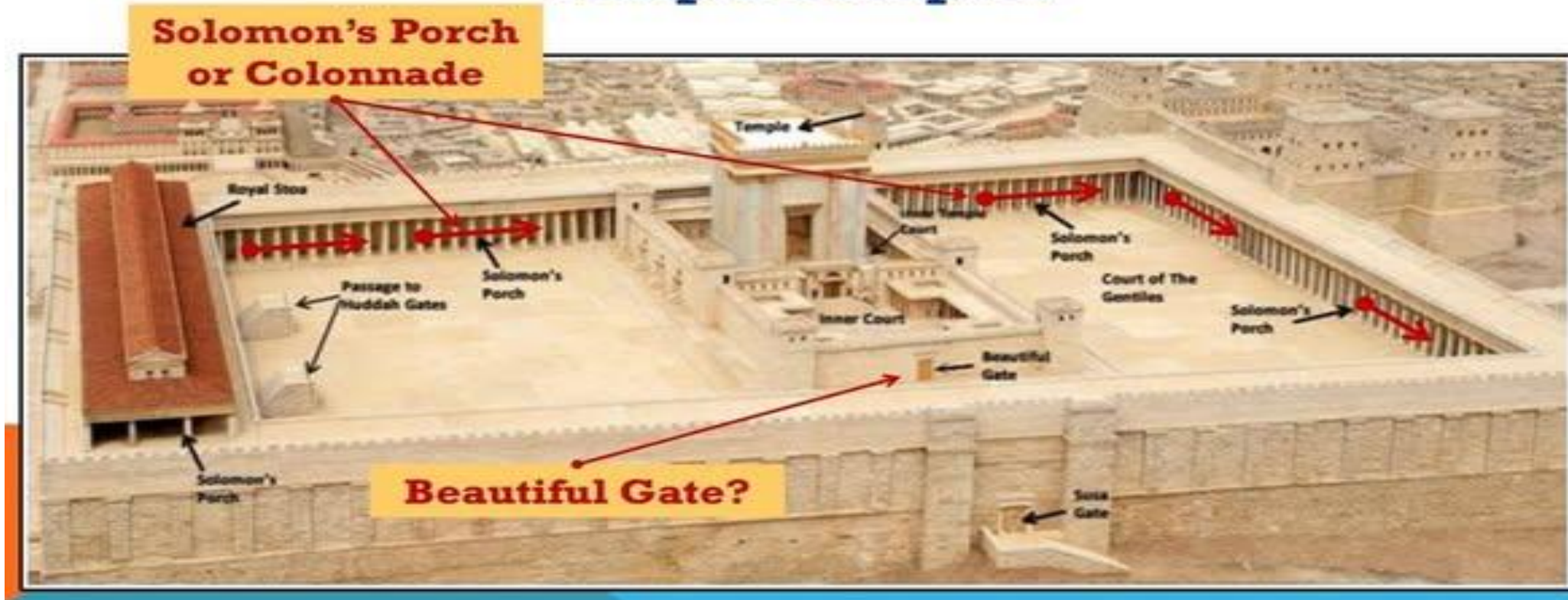

The suffering Servant whom they rejected and crucified him. God raised him from the dead.



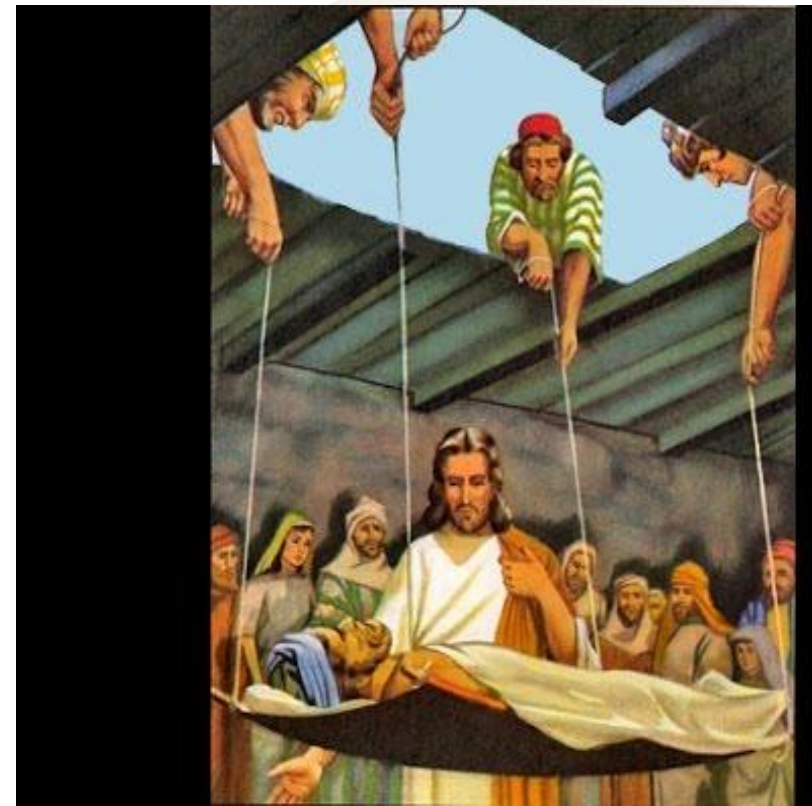
3. The Spirit Calls People to Repentance and Restoration

A Prophecy Fulfilled

The Spirit Moves Us with Compassion

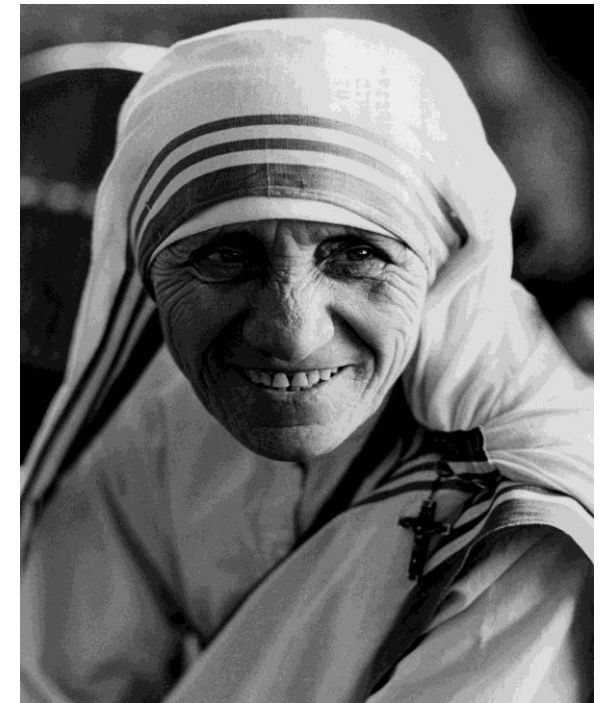
*Be sensitive to the Spirit's leading
