- Put to death... whatever belongs to the earthly nature

Stop practicing:

- Sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed
- anger /rage, malice and wrong speech like slander, filthy language and lies

Christian relationships: Church and family

- ¹² Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ¹³ Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
- ¹⁴ And over all these <u>virtues</u> put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
- ¹⁵ Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.


Kingdom citizens

Kingdom virtues

Virtue

- a behavior that shows high moral standards: doing what is right and avoiding what is wrong
- compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
- bear with each other.....
- forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone.

Put on love and peace:

- ¹⁴ And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
- ¹⁵ Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace.
- Love sums up and leads the virtues.
- Peace of Christ is why we can forgive others


And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power ... to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ


EPHESIANS 3:17-18 NIV

- Enable us to show compassion, kindness, gentleness and patience

Love and compassion of Jesus (Luke 7)

• ¹¹ Soon afterward, Jesus went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and a large crowd went along with him. ¹² As he approached the town gate, a dead person was being carried out—the only son of his mother, and she was a widow. And a large crowd from the town was with her. ¹³ When the Lord saw her, his heart went out to her and he said, "Don't cry."






- Love / compassion led to kindness to the widow
- Her only son was from raised from the dead

Peace of Christ



When we are wronged,

- we can forgive others because we have been forgiven
- We bear no resentment or bitterness in our hearts because we have this peace.



- No desire for revenge or retaliation
- No need to be anxious

(Philippians 4:7)

Mindset of Christ (Philippians 2):

- ³ Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, ⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.
- ⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus
- Don't act out of selfishness or pride

In humility:

- value others above yourselves
- look to the interest of others

- if being in a community of the Spirit means anything to you.....Agree with each other, love each other.....Don't push your way to the front; don't sweet-talk your way to the top.
- Put yourself aside, and help others get ahead. Don't be obsessed with getting your own advantage. Forget yourselves long enough to lend a helping hand. (Message)

Colossians 3:18-21: Family Relationships


- ¹⁸ Wives, submit yourselves to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.
- ¹⁹ Husbands, love your wives and do not be harsh with them.
- ²⁰ Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.
- ²¹ Fathers, do not embitter your children, or they will become discouraged.

Husbands....wives

- Love your wives and <u>do not be</u> <u>harsh</u> with them. (Colossians 3:19).
- Love as Christ love the church and gave Himself up for her... <u>sacrificially</u> (Ephesians 5:25)
- Be <u>considerate</u>.... joint heirs in Christ (1 Peter 3:5-7)



Bible Picture of Christ's Body



- Love sacrificially as Christ love the Church:
- value his wife above himself
- consider her needs before his own.

Do not be harsh but be considerate

- Show them love
- Treat with compassion, humility, kindness, gentleness and patience
- Bear with them....
- Forgive....when they fail to submit

1 Peter 3:7

- ⁷ Husbands, in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers.
- Warning....
- Prayers not answered if fail to be considerate

Wives.....husbands

<u>Submit</u> yourselves to your husbands:

- as is <u>fitting in the Lord</u>.
 (Colossians 3:18)
- as you do to the Lord

(Ephesians 5:22-24)

Submission of Christ

Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross! Philippians 2:6-8

- Equal with God
- No compulsion, only joy
- Do His Father's will

Submission:

• put yourself under someone, for a good and proper purpose.

Christian submission:

- obedient to His will.
- totally voluntary.
- equality not in question.


- Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. (Ephesians 5:21)

- helper suitable for man (Genesis 2:18)

> Suitable: Complementary




"Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord..."

Parent / child


- Children, obey your parents in everything, for <u>this pleases the</u> <u>Lord</u>.

Parent / child issues

- Unreasonable parenting embitter or exasperate children
- Failure (fathers) train and instruct spiritual principles
- Children lack obedience and honor of parents

Stewardship:


- Train them in Word

- God is good and will hear your cries to Him... work out for good Romans 8:28

- Forgive parents....because it pleases the Lord


Summary
