

Matthew 23:1-12

Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples: ² 'The teachers of the law and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat. ³ So you must be careful to do everything they tell you. But do not do what they do, for they do not practise what they preach. 4 They tie up heavy, cumbersome loads and put them on other people's shoulders, but they themselves are not willing to lift a finger to move them.



- ⁵ 'Everything they do is done for people to see: they make their phylacteries wide and the tassels on their garments long;
 ⁶ they love the place of honour at banquets and the most important seats in the synagogues;
 ⁷ they love to be greeted with respect in the market-places and to be called "Rabbi" by others.
- ⁸ 'But you are not to be called "Rabbi", for you have one Teacher, and you are all brothers. ⁹ And do not call anyone on earth "father", for you have one Father, and he is in heaven. ¹⁰ Nor are you to be called instructors, for you have one Instructor, the Messiah. ¹¹ The greatest among you will be your servant. ¹² For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.



<u>Characteristics of the</u> <u>False Hypocritic Teachers</u>

- Preach not practice
- Bring burden not blessing
 - Seek self-glory not God
- Misunderstand true greatness and service



Preach Not Practice

Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples:

² 'The teachers of the law and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat. ³ So you must be careful to do everything they tell you. But do not do what they do, for they do not practise what they preach.

They are Hypocrites - Empty Religion

Say the right things but live the wrong way

Burden Not Blessing

⁴ They tie up heavy, cumbersome loads and put them on other people's shoulders, but they themselves are not willing to lift a finger to move them.

Cold Heartless Religion

Impose heavy burden with their rigid religiosity

Distorted the Truth of God Work vs. Grace Driven Obedience

The Sovereign God is a Compassionate God not a Cold Control Freak

Seek Glory Not God

⁵ 'Everything they do is done for people to see: they make their phylacteries wide and the tassels on their garments long; ⁶ they love the place of honour at banquets and the most important seats in the synagogues;

They love to show off

Seek Applause of man Not Approval of God









They revelled in honorific title

⁷ they love to be greeted with respect in the market-places and to be called "Rabbi" by others.

⁸ 'But you are not to be called "Rabbi", for you have one Teacher, and you are all brothers.

Pride and Self-seeking glory

Seek honour, respect, and adoration that are due to God alone



They Misunderstand Ministry

¹¹ The greatest among you will be your servant.

¹² For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.

True Greatness is Humble Service

God's servants must serve humbly by His grace for His glory

- **Self-exalting vs. Humble Service** *Misunderstood our ministry of Humble Service?*




Live the Authentic Christian life

True Greatness is Humble Service

"Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted."



Don't seek to be first, be willing to be last

Mark 9:35 'Anyone who wants to be first must be the very last, and the servant of all.'







Be Servants, Not Celebrities

Matthew 20:26-27

²⁶ Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant,

²⁷ and whoever wants to be first must be your slave -

Don't serve for applause of man, serve for His glory
