"I will give you my land, my farm, my properties, my shops and my money in the banks as your inheritance."


"On one condition, you must bring me a bone of Tyrannosaurus Rex!"

4 Then the word of the LORD came to him: heir, but a son who is your own flesh and blo






5 He took him outside and said, "Look up at the sky and count the stars—if indeed you can count them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be."

8-10 But Abram said, "Sovereign LORD, how can I know that I will gain possession of it?" So the LORD said to him, "Bring me a heifer, a goat and a ram, each three years old, along with a dove and a young pigeon." Abram brought all these to him, cut them in two and arranged the halves opposite each other;...

17 When the sun had set and darkness had fallen, a smoking firepot with a blazing torch appeared and passed between the pieces.

1-2 Now Sarai, Abram's wife, had borne him no children. But she had an Egyptian slave named Hagar; so she said to Abram, "The LORD has kept me from having children. Go, sleep with my slave; perhaps I can build a family through her." Abram agreed to what Sarai said.



4-6 He slept with Hagar, and she conceived. When she knew she was pregnant, she began to despise her mistress. Sarai mistreated Hagar; so she fled from her.

11-12 The angel of the LORD found Hagar near a spring in the desert... "...name him Ishmael, for the LORD has heard of your misery." She gave this name to the LORD who spoke to her: "You are the God who sees me,"

1 When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to him and said, "I am God Almighty ; walk before me faithfully and be blameless.

2 Then I will make my (everlasting) covenant between me and you and will greatly increase your numbers."

4-5 "<u>As for me</u>, this is my covenant with you: You will be the father of many nations. .. your name will be Abraham, .."

9-10 Then God said to Abraham, "<u>As for you</u>, you must keep my covenant,This is my covenant with you and your descendants after you, the covenant you are to keep: Every male among you shall be circumcised.

15-17..., "<u>As for Sarai</u> your wife, you are no longer to call her Sarai; her name will be Sarah. I will bless her and will surely give you a son by her. ..." Abraham fell facedown; he laughed and said to himself, "Will a son be born to a man a hundred years old? Will Sarah bear a child at the age of ninety?" Abraham said to God, "If only Ishmael might live under your blessing!"

20 And <u>as for Ishmael</u>, I have heard you: I will surely bless him; I will make him fruitful and will greatly increase his numbers. He will be the father of twelve rulers, and I will make him into a great nation.

21 But my covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah will bear to you by this time next year."

2 Abraham looked up and saw three men standing nearby...

7-8 Then he ran to the herd and selected a choice, tender calf and .. he then brought some curds and milk and the calf that had been prepared, and set these before them. While they ate, he stood near them under a tree.



10-15 Then one of them said, "I will surely return to you about this time next year, and Sarah your wife will have a son." Now Sarah was listening at the entrance to the tent, which was behind him. ... Sarah laughed to herself as she thought, "After I am worn out and my lord is old, will I now have this pleasure?" ... "Why did Sarah laugh .. Is anything too hard for the LORD?..." Sarah was afraid, so she lied and said, "I did not laugh." But he said, "Yes, you did laugh."




