PSALMS 119:83

Wineskin in the smoke

- These bottles/bags were made from the skin of the goat's leg. The skin from the leg is stripped, fat from under skin removed, dried and tanned. Then stitched, reversed and sealed to be used as containers for water, milk or wine.
- These bottles/bags were very important to nomads in arid places. They are used for storing & carrying precious life sustaining fluid on their long journeys. They are used and reused as needed. But when the bags are empty they would sometime be hung up on the poles inside the tent.
- Because there was usually open fire inside the tent, the smoke and heat it would affect these empty, hung bags. Over time the bags would lose their elasticity, become dry, shriveled, brittle and cracked up. They also become black and dirty, covered with black soot from the smoke.
- "Wineskin in smoke" Empty skins, dried up, shriveled and covered with soot.

Meaning?

- The psalmist is lamenting feeling like "a wineskin in the hot, suffocating, blinding smoke" — a extended period of suffering, feeling helpless, probably waiting impatiently.
- Over time like the wineskin turning black, feeling dried out, shriveled and useless.
- Giving a sense of exhaustion, tiredness, joy-less (dried-up)
- Smoke and heat represent the constant physical affliction, worry, sickness, sorrows. Troubles and problems seem unending!!!
- Not only physical sufferings, but the mind can becomes troubled, depressed
- The inner being can become down-casted and disturbed.

Psalmist cries.....

- My soul faints with longing for Your salvation Ps 119:81
- My eyes fail looking for Your promise; I say, "When will You comfort me?" Ps 119:82
- How long must Your servant wait? Ps 119:84
- My mouth is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth; You lay me in the dust of death. Ps22:15
- Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me?
 Ps 42:5

- WHY? WHY? WHY?


Questions directed God?


- Why is it happening?


