Puzzled

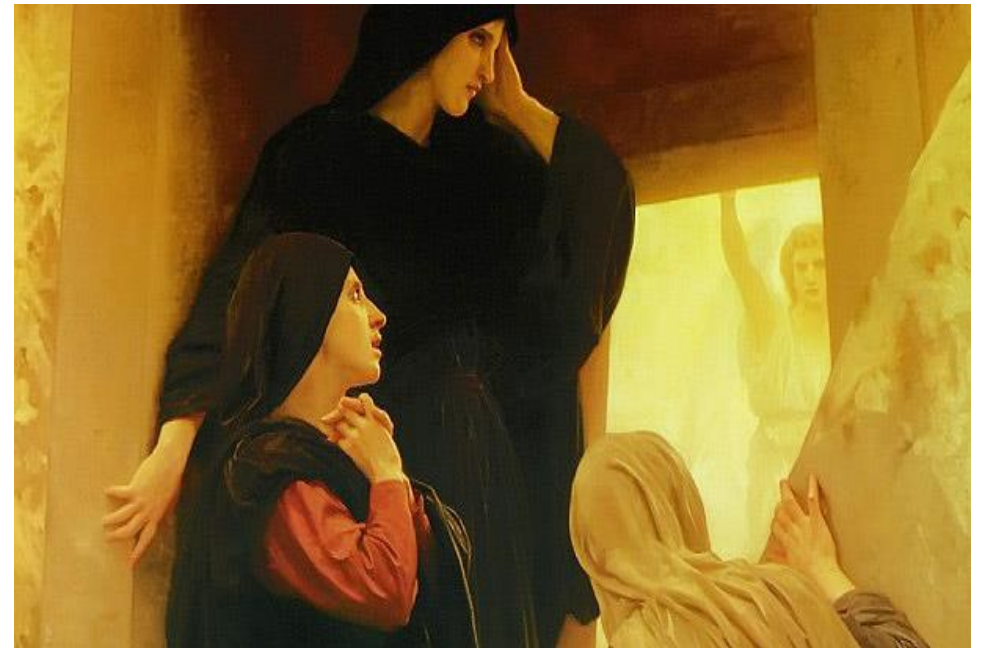
*“He has risen from the dead and

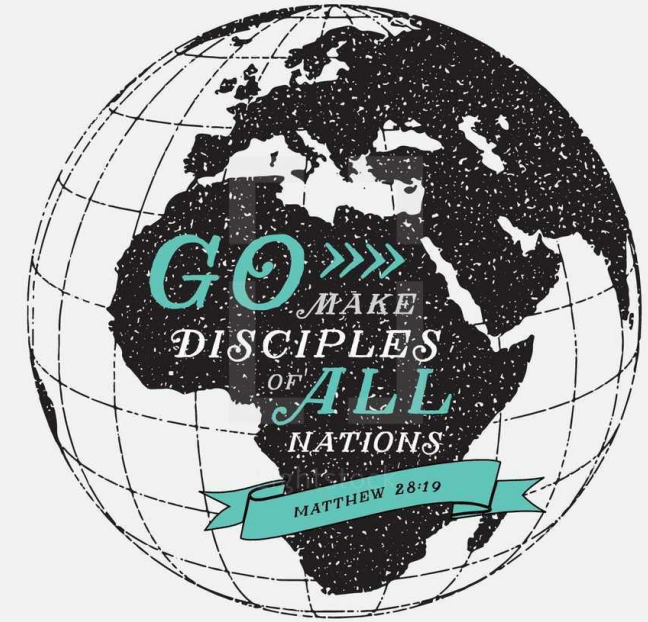
