


Priscilla and Aquila




Epenetus, Paul's first convert

Mary with the gift of help




Andronicus & Junia

The Imperial Households


Greet those who belong to the household of Aristobulus.

Greet my dear friend Persis, another woman who has worked very hard in the Lord.




Rufus and His Mother

His brother Alexander came to Paul's rescue in Ephesus' riot (Act; 19:33)




Two House Churches


