



Matthew 22:15-22

¹⁵ Then the Pharisees went out and laid plans to trap him in his words. 16 They sent their disciples to him along with the Herodians. 'Teacher,' they said, 'we know that you are a man of integrity and that you teach the way of God in accordance with the truth. You aren't swayed by others, because you pay no attention to who they are. ¹⁷ Tell us then, what is your opinion? Is it right to pay the poll-tax to Caesar or not?'

Saw through their Trickery, Sarcasm, Malice He exposed their hypocrisy


The Remarkable Answer Give it back to the Owners!

Give Back to God What is God's


We Bear His Image Gen 1:26

Submit to Authority but Worship God Only!




How do we worship God and respond to government?

God Established Government for Our Good Submit to it Wisely

Romans 13:1-2, 4

"Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. Consequently, he who rebels against the authority is rebelling against what God has instituted...4 For he is God's servant to do you good."



Give to government what is due them

Romans 13:6-7

"This is also why you pay taxes, for the authorities are God's servants, who give their full time to governing. Give everyone what you owe him: If you owe taxes, pay taxes; if revenue, then revenue; if respect, then respect; if honor, then honor."

We are to be Good Stewards of God

We must do what is good and right

Romans 13:3

Do you want to be free from fear of the one in authority? Then do what is right and he will commend you.

Be good citizens who uphold the rules and obey the law



We must pray for them

1 Timothy 2:1-2

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people -2 for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. ³ This is good, and pleases God our Saviour, 4 who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.
