 Appeasement required


Propitiation....atonement for sins and wrath of God satisfied

- Whoever lives in love....are being transformed to the likeness of Jesus





Forgiveness of sin


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 When struggling, suffering and confused by circumstances ..

Romans 8:38-39


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- No 'trials' can ever separate us from the love of God
